Erie Family Health Centers Moves Chicagoland Toward a Society Without HIV

After 30 fulfilling years of the nationally-recognized HIV/AIDS program, *Lending Hands for Life*, Erie Family Health Centers is the closest it's ever been to moving Chicagoland toward a society without HIV. With the program's behavioral health support in conjunction with medical care, Erie patients' viral suppression rate is currently at 92.5 percent, making *Lending Hands for Life* a leading program in the state. Erie is a partner of *Getting to Zero Illinois*, a state-wide initiative to

end the HIV epidemic in the state by 2030. Erie Family Health Centers encourages everybody to know their HIV status, utilizing awareness days like National HIV Testing Day (June 27) and inviting anybody interested in knowing their HIV status to take advantage of the health centers' testing services. At Erie Humboldt Park and Erie Evanston/Skokie, Erie offers walk-ins for free rapid HIV testing to anybody with a photo ID, meaning one



doesn't need to be a patient, a Chicago resident or even a citizen to get tested. The

walk-in testing is available Monday through Friday from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. at

Erie Humboldt Park (2750 W. North Avenue, Chicago) and on Fridays from 1 p.m.

to 4 p.m. at Erie Evanston/Skokie (1285 Hartrey Avenue, Evanston).

Venezuelan Actor Johnathan Jose Quintana Returns to Nickelodeon as Antagonist for Original Series 'Club 57'

Venezuelan actor Jonathan Jose Quintana, also known as John Freudman, continues his successful career with a new entertainment role in the highly anticipated Nickelodeon series "Club 57," which premiered in Latin America on May 6th. The 60-episode series is a musical melodrama that takes place between the present year and 1957. "Club 57" was created by Catharina Ledebor ("Grachi", "Talia in the Kitchen", "Vikki RPM") and is a co-production of Nickelodeon Latin America (a Viacom International Studios company) and the Italian production company Rainbow Group. "Club 57" follows teenagers Eva (Montaner) and her brother Ruben (Silva) who accidentally travel to the year 1957.

Eva falls in love with JJ (Frasconi) and decides to stay in the past, but her decision triggers a butterfly effect that changes their lives for the entertaining worst possible outcome. Jonathan plays the funny antagonistic role of Miguel, a television producer from the 50's who falls in love with Amelia (Castillo) and does everything to win her love and separate her from Manuel (Mercado). In addition to his character, Jonathan gives life with his voice to 'Droide', an artificial intelligence robot. Currently, Jonathan lives between Los Angeles and Miami and has begun his breakthrough in the American market with his participating in several new success short films. Lawndale News spoke with Jonathan about his life, career and great sense of humor!

LN: Why did you decide to change your name?

JQ: My name is Jonathan Jose Quintana and I decided to change it to my stage name because it suits me better. I was called many names. When I was little they called me Frodo. When I came to the US, I was called El Primo and then Johnnie. When I came to LA, I called myself John and it had some sort of assertiveness. I have been called Gabriel, Frenchie. I changed my name a year and a half ago.

LN: What role has your wife played in your career? You recently got married to her.

JQ: My career is very unstable. You have to travel from one place to another place. She is also in this business as an actress, host and singer. The fact that she understands me and is as adventurous as I am, is amazing. When we started going out and I started to get to know this person it was a no brainer to marry

this woman. I just knew. My little brother married his wife two years ago but have been together for seven years. I asked my brother who got married before me how did he know she was the one? My brother said when you know you know. When I met my wife I knew it from the get go and it didn't take long for me to stop looking.

LN: When and why did you start acting?

JQ: I have always been a showman. My mom got me in commercials when I was little. I always liked to make people laugh. It came natural to me. When I started getting some money out of it and I realized I was good at it, I thought "why not make my passion my income source?" From that point on I knew I had to make myself a product and do what I love. If you love what you do you are not working.

LN: Tell us about your role as a villain. What

makes it so intriguing?

JQ: It is very fun. It is exciting. I think we people are a mixture of good and bad and there is a balance. I try not to make my villain evil but give him a sense of why he is doing what he is doing to create a more real character. I give the character a reason why he is evil and I find what his final objective is. I never played a good guy and for some reason people see me as the bad guy (laughs). I am not a fearful guy; I am a goofy guy.

LN: Tell me about Club57. What makes this show unique?

JQ: It is a very interesting show. It caters for a variety of people. It is very trendy. For the people who like SciFi would be great. It has an element of the 50s. The protagonist travels back to the 50s and they are looking to find a way back to our own time. It is a very fun show to watch. It has music and singing and a lot

of everything. It also has an educational purpose - a segment towards teaching science to the kids.

LN: What else are you currently working on?

JQ: Currently I am studying in LA. There is a project with Telemundo I am working on but I can't say much. We are in the talks for the next soap opera. We are crossing fingers for Second Season of Club57.

LN: Advice and message to your fans?

JQ: Treat life as a big joke but be serious about your comedy because a good joke comes from reality. When you are being told a joke you have two ways to take it - you either get offended or laugh about it. Choose to laugh about life. It's the only one we have. Watch the show! I am very proud of the work we all did and people will enjoy it. Be out there and live happy!

Attorney General Raoul Highlights Resources for Immigrants in Illinois

Attorney General Kwame Raoul highlighted resources available to help immigrants, consulate offices and non-profit organizations to educate immigrants on their legal rights. In

light of reports that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement could conduct enforcement operations in cities around the country, including in Chicago, Attorney General Raoul highlighted the office's

"Know Your Rights" public awareness campaign to help immigrants living in Illinois understand their rights and responsibilities when interacting with law enforcement. "Know Your Rights" resources

are available free of charge on the Attorney General's website in English, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Hindi, Polish, Serbian and Urdu, along with a mobile version and printable pocket-sized guide. The materials summarize people's rights if confronted by an immigration agent or a police officer, detail what

to expect if immigration agents or police officers come to your home, and offer an explanation of your rights if you are arrested. They also provide important reminders about immigration documentation, tips for avoiding dishonest immigration service providers and links to additional resources.

The Attorney General's office does not request information about immigration or citizenship status from anyone who contacts the office or files a complaint. Attorney General Raoul encourages individuals to contact his office to report instances of discrimination or harassment by calling his Civil Rights Hotline at 1-877-581-3692.

Representatives García, Khanna Introduce Legislation to Boost Jobs and Wages



Representatives Jesús “Chuy” García (IL-04) and Ro Khanna (CA-17), introduced the Reward Work Act as a companion

to legislation by Senator Tammy Baldwin (D-WI). This bill will address the explosion in so-called “stock buybacks.” Since

the late 1970s, a growing share of economic growth has gone to Wall Street with little given to workers. This is especially true since

the passage of the 2017 tax overhaul. Since President Trump signed that bill, corporate firms have spent more than \$1 trillion on stock buybacks to pay out executives and shareholders. The Reward Work Act also gives workers a voice in choosing how their company is run by requiring public companies to directly elect one-third of the company’s board of directors and banning open-market stock buybacks. In the

Senate, the bill has been cosponsored by Senators Tammy Baldwin (WI), Elizabeth Warren (MA), Bernie Sanders (VT), and Brian Schatz (HI). This bill has been supported by organizations including AFL-CIO, Communication Workers of America, Public Citizens, Americans for Financial Reform and Take On Wall Street. Wells Fargo was the biggest beneficiary of this tax bill, according to *Vox*. The corporation has bought

back \$40 billion of its own stock while laying off workers and being involved in numerous consumer protection scandals. In 2018, Starbucks spent nearly \$6 billion on stock buybacks. If Starbucks reallocated money from share buybacks, every worker could receive a \$7,000 raise. Similarly, if Lowe’s, CVS and Home Depot did the same, each worker could receive at least 18,000 per year.

El Procurador General Raoul Destaca Recursos para los Inmigrantes en Illinois



El Procurador General Kwame Raoul destacó los recursos disponibles para ayudar a los inmigrantes, las oficinas del consulado y organizaciones no lucrativas a educar a los inmigrantes sobre sus derechos legales. En vista de reportes de que U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement pudo conducir operaciones de ejecución en toda ciudad del país, incluyendo Chicago, el Procurador General Raoul destacó la campaña de concientización pública “Conoce Tus Derechos” para ayudar a los inmigrantes que viven en Illinois a entender sus derechos

y responsabilidades cuando interactúan con la aplicación de la ley. Los recursos de “Conoce Tus Derechos” están disponibles en forma gratuita en la red del Procurador General en inglés, español, árabe, chino, hindi, polaco, serbio y urdu, junto con una versión móvil y una guía tamaño bolsillo para imprimir. Los materiales resumen los derechos de la gente si es confrontada por un agente de inmigración u oficial de policía, detalla que esperar si los agentes de inmigración o los oficiales de policía llegan a su casa y ofrecen una explicación sobre

sus derechos si usted es arrestado. También provee importantes recordatorios sobre documentación de inmigración, consejos para evitar proveedores de servicios de inmigración deshonrados y enlaces a recursos adicionales. La oficina del Procurador General no pide información sobre inmigración o ciudadanía de nadie que se comunique con la oficina o registre una queja. El Procurador General Raoul aconseja a las personas comunicarse con su oficina para reportar casos de discriminación o acoso, llamando a la Línea Directa de Derechos Civiles al 1-877-581-3692.

More Than Sixty Percent of City Colleges Students Surveyed Are Food or Housing Insecure, According to A New Report

According to a report released by the Hope Center for College, Community, and Justice at Temple University's College of Education, 64 percent of the City Colleges of Chicago students surveyed expressed food or housing insecurity. City Colleges of Chicago's Chancellor Juan Salgado unveiled the results as he introduced additional measures to address

some of the challenges the city's community college students face outside of the classroom, including an emergency fund and a dedicated housing coordinator. The national survey found that 44 percent of the City Colleges students who responded to the survey were food insecure in the prior 30 days, 54 percent were housing insecure in the previous year, and 15

percent of respondents were homeless in the previous year. More than 3,000 students from the seven colleges participated in the survey, or six percent of the 47,000 students enrolled in the Fall 2018 semester. City Colleges has launched an emergency fund for unforeseen, one-time crises, which is now available to students on a first-come, first-served basis. The fund



Be Aware of These Skincare Products When in Sun



You're all set for a fun day in the sun with your wide-brimmed hat to shield you from the UV rays, and you have given your waterproof SPF 30 or higher plenty of time to absorb into your skin. To play it safe, you have brought more suntan lotion to reapply after swimming or sweating. You are a dermatologist's dream- or so you think. Have you given any thought to what you applied to your skin the night before or that morning before your set out for your day? The answer is you probably

have not if you have concocted a skincare regimen that works for your skin type. We turned to Dr. Manish Shah, a Board-Certified Denver, Colorado plastic surgeon to reveal what types of products/ingredients sun worshippers should avoid and what can serve as safe substitutes.

Topical Acids Alpha and Beta Hydroxy Acids such as Glycolic, Lactic, and Salicylic Acids can cause the skin to be more susceptible to sun damage from being regularly exfoliated. These

ingredients are commonly used in anti-aging, skin-brightening, and acne-fighting products.

Alternative: While AHAs and BHAs only cause minimal photosensitivity, you wouldn't want to risk feeling that stinging sensation on your face. There are alternatives. Azelaic acid, found in wheat, rye and barley—comes in handy during the day as it is useful in the treatment of acne, rosacea, melasma and post-inflammatory hyperpigmentation and is not associated with the sun-

induced reaction.

Hydroquinone- Typically used in skin-lightening products. Although hydroquinone is stable in sunlight, it's not advisable to use it during the day as the sun's skin-darkening effects are stronger than hydroquinone's bleaching effect. Additionally, hydroquinone actually reduces your body's ability to create enough pigment to protect you from UV rays.

Alternative: Vitamin C is an excellent alternative to hydroquinone, as it is an antioxidant and combats

dark spots while also having anti-inflammatory and anti-aging properties. Retinol and Retinol Derivatives encourage cell turnover, which exposes delicate, new skin. These newer layers of skin can be more sensitive to the sun. With enough sunscreen protection, newer formulations of retinol can be safely used during the day, but experts still advise limiting its use to nighttime especially for those who have sensitive skin.

Alternative: Bakuchiol is the new, clinically proven "natural retinol,"

a powerful plant-based retinol alternative that decreases skin sensitivity to the sun. It is derived from the leaves and seeds of the babchi plant and helps to heal, calm and soothe the skin, via its anti-inflammatory and antibacterial properties.

Two Hours Per Week is Key Dose of Nature for Health and Wellbeing



Spending at least two hours a week in nature may be a crucial threshold for promoting health and wellbeing, according to a new large-scale study. Research led by the University of Exeter, published in *Scientific Reports* and funded by NIHR, found that people who spend at least 120 minutes in nature a week

are significantly more likely to report good health and higher psychological wellbeing than those who don't visit nature at all during an average week. However, no such benefits were found for people who visited natural settings such as town parks, woodlands, country parks and beaches for less than 120 minutes a week. There is growing

evidence that merely living in a greener neighborhood can be good for health, for instance by reducing air pollution. The data for the current research came from Natural England's Monitor of Engagement with the Natural Environment Survey, the world's largest study collecting data on people's weekly contact with the natural world.

la naturaleza a la semana son considerablemente más propensos a reportar una buena salud y un mejor bienestar psicológico que quienes no visitan la naturaleza en lo absoluto durante una semana. Sin embargo, tales beneficios no fueron encontrados en gente que visitó lugares naturales como parques de la ciudad, bosques y playas por lo menos 120 minutos a la semana. Hay

una creciente evidencia de que simplemente vivir en un barrio más verde puede ser bueno para la salud, por ejemplo al reducir la contaminación ambiental. El dato para investigaciones actuales llegó de Monitor of Engagement de Natural England con el estudio de Ambiente Natural, el mayor estudio recopilando datos sobre el contacto semanal de las personas con el mundo natural.
