## **CDPH Modifies Emergency Travel Order**



The Chicago Department of Public Health has updated the Emergency Travel Order to provide clearer guidance to those traveling to and from the city as it works to stem the further spread of the virus. Starting January 15, the travel order will be divided into two levels instead of three: orange states and territories above 15 cases per day, per 100,000, and yellow states and territories below 15 cases per day, per 100,000. The travel order criteria have been revised to combine the "red" and "orange" categories, so all formerly

above 15 cases/day/100k "red" states have been moved to "orange" tier restrictions, regardless of how their case rate has changed or how it relates to Chicago's case rate. Previously, the red states were those with a higher daily case rate per 100,000 than Chicago. The guidance for each tier is: •Yellow: States with a rolling 7-day average less than 15 cases/day/100k residents. •No quarantine or pre-arrival test required. Maintain strict masking, social distancing and avoidance of in-person gatherings

•Orange: States have a rolling 7-day average

## Senator Fine: 'education reforms ensure equal access to opportunities'

To help all Illinois students succeed in higher education and the career world, State Senator Laura Fine (D-Glenview) is supporting legislation to improve equity in the Illinois school system. The legislation makes a number of changes to education policy in the state, from expanding eligibility for early childhood services to revamping the American history curriculum, in an effort to reduce systemic inequities in K-12 and

higher education. The bill modifies several K-12 course requirements to meet colleges' prerequisites, establishing that students must take two years of laboratory science and two years of a foreign language (or sign language) to graduate high school starting in the 2024-2025 school year. Additionally, to ensure all students are prepared for the demands of college and the modern workforce, students must receive one

vear of computer literacy training. The legislation also takes specific steps to improve outcomes for Black students, including reforming the way Black history is taught through an inclusive American history curriculum and removing barriers that prevent Black people and other people of color from becoming teachers. House Bill 2170 passed the Senate and now heads to the House for final consideration before heading to the governor.

## **City Health Names Chicago A Gold Medal City**



Chicago has received a gold medal as one of the nation's highest performing cities when it comes to passing policies that improve the health and well-being of its residents for the fourth year in a row, according to the 2020 CityHealth Annual Report. The CityHealth report takes a close look at whether the nation's 40 largest cities have nine key policies in place that experts say help residents lead healthier lives and communities thrive. Each year, cities are awarded gold, silver, and bronze medals according to the strength and number of the policies they have in place. The data used in the assessment are produced by the Center for Public Health Law Research at Temple University's Beasley School of Law.
