Earlier this month the nonprofit Chicago Parks Foundation (CPF) announced the second annual of "Pitch In for the Parks!" an effort designed to help maintain the city's 600 public parks clean. Last year, the initiative drew in 2,000 volunteers for 350 park clean-ups and this year, CPF Executive Director Willa Iglitzen Lang hopes to see that number grow. We spoke to Lang about the serenity Chicago Parks bring to residents as well as the Foundation's future goals.

**Love for the Parks**  
During the pandemic when we were all confined to our homes, Chicago Parks became a vital role in mental health. You could take walks down the lakefront, when it was open; you could enjoy the sun. We really saw people connecting in a safe and responsible way. It was wonderful to see. It is always lovely to see people from around the City enjoying their neighborhood park.

### Pitch In

Prior to the pandemic, our Foundation held multiple events around the Chicago Parks, such as meditation, cooking classes, woodwork to name a few. It all stopped once COVID hit Chicago and we quickly had to think of a way to get residents to support their local parks. We know people always want to give back and not in the financial sense. People want to give their time and support. Because we couldn't maintain our staff during the pandemic, we came up with the idea of Pitch In for the Parks to get people excited about meeting their neighbors, rolling up their sleeves, and helping to beautify their parks. We supply all the necessary items to help clean the parks. All volunteers have to do is to step up and pitch in. This year, we have 100 unique groups already signed up

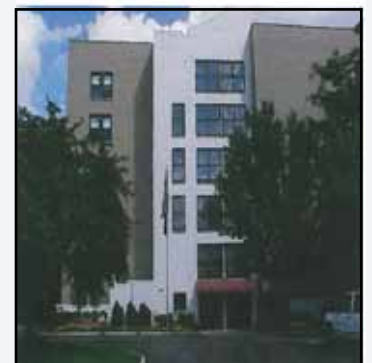

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## Leave the Fireworks to the Pros this 4th of July

The Town of Cicero will issue fines of \$750 for individuals caught using illegal fireworks during this Fourth of July season, Town President Larry Dominick announced. Last year, we saw many serious accidents in the Town of Cicero involving individuals who used their own fireworks,” Dominick cautioned. Dominick noted that last year, a woman lost three of fingers from a fireworks explosion in her hand. Another man lost his entire left arm when the fireworks exploded. And a young child lost an eye, Dominick said. “These were terrible tragedies



that could have easily been avoided,” Dominick said. “Avoid serious injuries. Leave the fireworks to the professionals. Don’t jeopardize your safety or the safety of your loved ones by playing with fireworks. They can be very dangerous in the wrong hands.” The Town of Cicero Police will aggressively enforce

the law banning the use of fireworks. “If you are caught using fireworks, you will be arrested and you will face a \$750 fine,” Dominick said. “This is to enforce the public safety.” There is no Town of Cicero Fireworks Display planned for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Weekend as the town and community come out of Coronavirus restrictions. Instead,

President Dominick urged residents to enjoy the public fireworks displays including one planned by the Town of Cicero for the annual carnival that will be held from August 5 through August 8<sup>th</sup> at Cicero Community Park at 34<sup>th</sup> and Laramie Avenue. The fireworks display will be showcased at dusk on Sunday, August 8.

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## Deje los Fuegos Artificiales a los Profesionales este 4 de Julio

El Municipio de Cicero expedirá multas de \$750 a personas sorprendidas usando fuegos artificiales ilegales durante la temporada del Cuatro de Julio, anunció el Presidente de Cicero, Larry Dominick. El año pasado vimos muchos accidentes graves en Cicero causados por personas que utilizaron sus propios fuegos artificiales”, advirtió Dominick. Dominick hizo notar que el año pasado una mujer perdió tres dedos por una explosión de fuegos artificiales en su mano, dijo Dominick. “Estas fueron tragedias terribles que podrían haberse evitado fácilmente”, dijo

Dominick. “Evite lesiones graves. Deje los fuegos artificiales en manos de los profesionales. No ponga en peligro su seguridad o la seguridad de sus seres queridos jugando con cohetes. Pueden ser muy peligrosos en las manos equivocadas”. La policía de Cicero hará cumplir enérgicamente la ley que prohíbe el uso de fuegos artificiales. Si usted es sorprendido usando fuegos artificiales será arrestado y enfrentará una multa de \$750”, dijo Dominick. “Esto para hacer cumplir la seguridad pública”. No se ha planeado una exhibición de fuegos artificiales en Cicero para

el fin de semana del 4 de julio, ya que Cicero y la comunidad está saliendo de las restricciones del Coronavirus. En vez de ello, el Presidente Dominick exhorta a los residentes que disfruten las exhibiciones públicas de fuegos artificiales incluyendo la que Cicero planea para la feria anual que se celebrará del 5 al 8 d agosto en el Parque Comunitario de Cicero, en la Calle 34th y la Ave. Laramie. **H**otel workers, labor leaders, and City Officials signed the Hotel Worker Right to Return to Work ordinance this week. This piece of legislation requires that as guests return and hotels increase staffing, hotels offer employees their previous positions or other positions for which they are qualified before hiring any replacement workers.

“We are in a crucial moment of our city’s reopening to fully support the workforce that allows our city to thrive,” said Committee on Workforce Development Chairman Susan Sadlowski-Garza, 10th Ward. “This ordinance reaffirms our commitment to having a strong, vibrant and skilled workforce that will propel our city forward and shows our hotel workers that we appreciate their hard work from pre-covid days and honor the sacrifices they made while the city was

same training a newly hired worker would receive. “My job at the hotel is all I’ve known for almost two



shut down.” Over the course of the pandemic, at least 62 Chicago hotels have laid off over 12,000 Chicago hotel workers. This ordinance is an important step in ensuring workers’ rights following economic recovery from the

pandemic. According to the ordinance provisions, hotel workers would be qualified for a position if they previously held the same or similar position at their hotel. They would also be qualified for a role in the same department or division and offered the

Esta legislación requiere que según la gente regresa y los hoteles aumentan el personal, los hoteles ofrezcan a los empleados sus posiciones anteriores u otras posiciones para las cuales estén calificados, antes de contratar cualquier trabajador de reemplazo.

“Estamos en un momento crucial de la reapertura de nuestra ciudad para apoyar en su totalidad la fuerza laboral que permite a la ciudad prosperar”, dijo la Directora del Comité de Desarrollo de Fuerza Laboral, Susan Sadlowski Garza, del Distrito 10. “Esta ordenanza reafirma nuestro compromiso de tener una fuerza laboral fuerte, vibrante y diestra, que haga prosperar nuestra ciudad y muestre a nuestros trabajadores de hoteles que apreciamos su trabajo de los días anteriores al covid y honramos los sacrificios que tuvieron que hacer mientras la ciudad estuvo cerrada”.

allowing 15 days for the hotel to cure any alleged violation. The ordinance, which immediately goes into effect, remains in effect until December 31, 2023.

The program, Learn and Earn: Career Connections,

is for residents ages 13-15. It starts July 6 and runs through August 14. Led by content experts, teen participants will explore the field of entrepreneurship, culinary and hospitality, healthcare careers, computer science and coding, manufacturing and technology, communications, or arts and technology. With

the guidance and support of a certified teacher and use of an adaptive online learning program, teens will also practice math and literacy skills as part of their work. The programs are designed to engage the teens in facilitated reflection and workshops that support their efforts to connect their career interests to necessary

21<sup>st</sup> century and academic skills. As with all After School Matters programs, the teens will receive a monetary stipend for their participation. After School Matters typically works with teens 14-19, but this new program focuses on younger teens, ages 13-15, exposing them to potential career fields of interest and tailoring academic skills

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# Hernandez Extends Immigration Assistance for Survivors of Human Trafficking

A new law spearheaded by state Rep. Elizabeth “Lisa” Hernandez, D-Cicero, will assist immigrants who are survivors of human trafficking. “We must support survivors of human trafficking, regardless of their immigration status,” said Hernandez. “Survivors have faced life-altering and horrible conditions that no one should have to experience. Ensuring they receive a helping hand with basic needs like medical, food, and financial assistance is crucial to the recovery of their health and safety.” Hernandez’s Senate Bill 506 extends the Cash and Food Assistance for Non-Citizen Victims of Trafficking, Torture, or Other Serious Crimes program. The program provides access to Medicaid, food supplies, and financial assistance, but was meant to expire



by the start of 2022. Due to the efforts of Hernandez and stakeholders, these services have been

extended permanently to bring significantly needed relief to survivors. Please visit the Illinois

Hernández. “Los sobrevivientes han enfrentado condiciones horribles que ponen en peligro la vida y que nadie debería experimentar. Asegurarnos que reciben una mano de ayuda con las necesidades básicas, como ayuda médica alimentaria y financiera, es crucial para la recuperación de su salud y seguridad”. El proyecto 506 del Senado extiende el programa de Ayuda de Dinero y Alimentos para las Víctimas de Tráfico, Tortura y Otros Graves Crímenes, no Ciudadanas. El programa provee acceso a Medicaid, suministros de comida y asistencia financiera, pero iba a expirar a principios del 2022. Debido a los esfuerzos de la Rep. Hernández y simpatizantes, estos servicios han sido extendidos permanentemente para brindar considerable alivio a los sobrevivientes necesitados. 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# High School Students Receive Grants from Union League Boys and Girls Clubs

Lolla Days consisted of four City of Chicago vaccination sites that were transformed into a Lollapalooza experience for those receiving their COVID-19 vaccines to enjoy. Each site featured DJs and live music, custom Lollapalooza branded giveaways, and meet-and-greets with radio personalities



More than 200 Chicagoans were vaccinated and received their pass to the music festival. Additionally, there were several Pride-themed vaccination events that took place over the weekend including Pride in the Park at Millennium Park and Pride events at Navy Pier. Those that stopped by were able to receive their COVID-19 vaccines

and partake in the festivities. The Chicago Department of Public Health also hosted a special COVID-19 vaccination event in front of the American Indian Center on June 22<sup>nd</sup> in Albany Park. Attendees were treated to live drum and dance

“Mi trabajo en el hotel es todo lo que he hecho por casi dos décadas. Como mujer de 46 años que soy, es muy difícil encontrar un nuevo trabajo”, dijo Erika Hernández, residente de Humboldt Park cuyo hotel de lujo en el centro la despidió debido a la pandemia. “Gracias a esta ordenanza, se que puedo regresar a trabajar en el trabajo que me gusta. Ayudará a protegerme, a mí y a muchas mujeres que están en el mismo caso”. Los trabajadores de hotel pueden solicitar el cumplimiento de esta ordenanza a través de una acción civil después de notificar a sus hoteles y esperar 5 días para que el hotel solucione una supuesta violación.
