New Museum Exhibit Gives Visitors Sneak Peek at How Animals Jump, Swim, and Fly



A cheetah running up to 70 miles per hour. A bird that flaps its wings against the wind. A burr that sticks to your sock. All are examples of nature's incredible bioengineering that allows organisms to run, jump, swim, fly -- and yes, even cling. The Machine Inside: Biomechanics, lets visitors get a closer look at these marvels of nature and more in the immersive new exhibition opening at the Field Museum on Sept. 3rd. The exhibition represents a range of research from scientists at the Field, showing an incredible array of biodiversity found in plants and animals we know as well as some that may be unfamiliar. Biomechanics gives visitors a chance to learn about animals they might not have heard of before, like luna moths that use their fluffy antennae to smell a potential mate from seven miles away. Eligible Back-to-School Expenses Could Yield Tax Benefits



With back-to-school time upon us, the Illinois Department of Revenue (IDoR) is reminding taxpayers that they may be able to claim school expenses for their K-12 students on their 2021 Illinois individual income tax returns. Qualified educational expenses include tuition, and book and lab fees in excess of \$250 paid to the school where the student is enrolled on a full-time basis. For home schooled students - book rental, and lab fees greater than \$250 are eligible when attending a qualified home school program. The Illinois Education Expense Credit allows parents or legal guardians of a full-time K-12 student under the age of 21 to take a 25 percent tax credit on qualified education expenses over \$250. The total credit may not exceed \$750 for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2017, regardless of the number of qualifying students.
