

Toma agua – suficiente!



Conoce las señales de una deshidratación.

¿Sientes la piel seca, irritada, inflamada, con comezón o sensitiva? Esto es un síntoma de deshidratación. ¿Tienes un dolor de cabeza o te sientes mareado o fatigado? esto también es un síntoma. Calambres musculares, una respiración rápida, desmayos y no orinar (o tener una orina de un color amarillo muy oscuro) son otros síntomas. Si estás experimentando cualquiera de estos síntomas, la solución más sencilla es retirarte del calor y beber suficientes líquidos.

Ingiere alimentos con alto contenido de agua.

¿Sabías que aproximadamente el 80 or ciento de nuestra ingestión de agua proviene del agua que bebemos? El otro 20 por ciento proviene de la comida. Todas las frutas y vegetales enteros contienen algo de agua, pero come estos para un beneficio máximo: pepinos, apio, tomates, rábanos, chiles, coliflor, melón, espinacas, fresas, bróccoli y uvas. Todas ellas contienen 90 por ciento de agua o más. **Refréscate.**

Una hidratación apropiada no se consigue solo con beber agua – también se trata de regular la temperatura de tu cuerpo. Durante el verano, cuando el riesgo de una insolación es más alto, viste ropa suelta, ligera y en colores claros; programa los deportes fuertes y las actividades físicas durante las horas más frescas del día; protégete del sol con un sombrero u otros accesorios para dar sombra; bebe agua con frecuencia; y rocíate con una botella de spray si sientes demasiado calor.



Stay Hydrated During Summer Heat

With temperatures rising this week, getting enough to drink and keeping cool while playing outdoor activities is extremely important. Dehydration can be a serious condition that can lead to a multitude of issues ranging from swollen feet to a headache to life-threatening illnesses such as heat stroke. According to the American Heart Association, average of approximately 700 people succumb to heat stroke each year. Heatstroke requires emergency treatment. Untreated heatstroke can quickly damage your brain, heart, kidneys and muscles. The damage worsens the longer treatment is delayed, increasing your risk of serious complications or death. Here are a few tips to help stay hydrated this summer.

Drink water—and plenty of it!

Start by drinking a cup of water each morning when you wake up or a glass before bed. Have another glass with every meal. Drink one or two cups after working out. To ward off dehydration, drink fluids gradually throughout the day.

Know the signs of dehydration.

Does your skin feel dry, irritated, inflamed, itchy, or sensitive? That's a sign of dehydration. Experiencing a headache or feeling dizzy or fatigued? These are signs, too. Muscle cramps, rapid breathing, fainting, and not urinating (or having very dark yellow urine) are others. If you're experiencing any of these symptoms, the simple solution is to get out of the heat and drink plenty of liquids.

Eat foods with high water content.

Did you know that approximately 80 percent of our water intake comes from drinking water? The other 20 percent comes from food. All whole fruits and vegetables contain some water, but snack on these for maximum benefit: cucumbers, celery, tomatoes, radishes, peppers, cauliflower, watermelon, spinach, strawberries, broccoli, and grapefruit. They all contain 90 percent water or higher.

Cool down.



Proper hydration isn't just about drinking water—it's about regulating your body temperature, too. During summer, when the risk for heat stroke is at its highest, wear light, loose-fitting clothing in light colors; schedule strenuous sports and physical activities during cooler times of the day; protect yourself from the sun with hats and other shade accessories; take drink breaks often; and mist yourself with a spray bottle if you become overheated.

Illinois Summer Youth Music Announces Return of Hip Hop Camp

Illinois Summer Youth Music is back with its annual Hip Hop Camp at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. In its fifth year, the week-long intensive music camp led by experienced faculty, Adam Kruse and Lamont Holden, strives to diversify the realm of musical excellence and exploration. For the summer of 2022, the Illinois Summer Youth Music Hip Hop program will continue its legacy of providing a platform for aspiring youth musicians. Under the tutelage of experienced music educators and guest artists, youth from grades 5-12 will participate in intense musicmaking. Attendees will participate in songwriting workshops, beat-making labs, and sampling demos from local artists. At the end of the camp, students perform their songs in a free public show for a live audience. The ISYM platform shows community

CDPH Investigates Monkeypox Infections, Asks the Public to Take Precautions this Summer


The Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) continues to investigate reports of monkeypox cases in Chicago residents and is asking people to take proper precautions when in spaces or situations where monkeypox could be spread through close or intimate contact. As of June 12, 2022, Chicago has identified seven confirmed cases of monkeypox, and CDPH continues to work closely with the Illinois Department of Public Health and other local public health departments

to identify other potential cases. Some of the current cases involve individuals who recently traveled to Europe. One Chicago resident reported attending the International Mr. Leather (IML) conference in Chicago from May 26-30. Additionally, residents from another state who were diagnosed with monkeypox also reported attending the IML conference. CDPH sent communication to public health departments around the country about its ongoing investigation to request notification of any

additional cases who visited Chicago from May 26-30. In the United States, 49 confirmed cases have been reported in 16 states and the District of Columbia. Most of the infected individuals have reported only mild symptoms, and none have died. Suspected cases may present with flu-like symptoms early on and progress to lesions that may begin on one part of the body and spread to other areas. Illness could be clinically confused with sexually transmitted infections like syphilis or
