

El Proyecto 2471 de la Cámara, la legislación Comidas Escolares Saludables para Todos, aprobada por la Cámara y el Senado de Illinois y allana el camino para que los estudiantes de Illinois no tengan hambre y estén listos para crecer, aprender y prosperar. El Proyecto 2471 de la Cámara crea el programa Comidas Escolares para Todos para proveer fondos del estado a las escuelas de Illinois para que puedan ofrecer comidas escolares gratis y de calidad a todos los niños que las necesitan y deseen, sin importar el ingreso familiar. El programa usará al máximo el existente programa federal y ampliará el acceso a comidas escolares gratuitas, ayudando a reducir el estigma muchas veces asociado con el que si califica o no para comidas, a precio reducido o gratis. Illinois



se une a una lista de otros estados, trabajando para llenar las brechas dejadas por el Congreso cuando expiraron las exenciones que brindaron comidas gratuitas a todos los niños durante la pandemia del COVID-19. Minnesota, Colorado, Nuevo México, Maine y California han aprobado y patrocinado la legislación comidas gratuitas en sus estados. La coalición afiliados de Illinois, incluyendo a líderes de educación, grupos de salud pública, padres y defensores anti-hambre han estado apoyando esta propuesta. Se calcula cuesta alrededor de \$115 millones el primer año y hasta \$194 millones en años futuros, dependiendo cuantas escuelas y estudiantes participen. Si es convertida en ley y totalmente patrocinada, las familias tal vez no necesiten preocuparse por pagar las comidas estudiantiles este próximo año escolar.

House Bill 2471 creates the Healthy School Meals for All program to provide state funding to Illinois schools to enable them to offer quality, free school meals to all children who need and want one, no matter their family's income. The program would maximize use of an existing Federal program and expand access to free school meals, helping to reduce the stigma often associated with qualifying for free or reduced-price meals. Illinois joins a list of other states working to fill the gaps left by Congress when the waivers that provided free meals to all kids during

the COVID-19 pandemic expired. Minnesota, Colorado, New Mexico, Maine, and California have all passed and funded free school meals legislation in their states. The coalition of Illinois partners, including education leaders, public health groups, parents, and anti-hunger advocates have been supporting this proposal. It is estimated to cost around \$115 million in the first year, and up to \$194 million in future years, depending on how many schools and students opt-in. If signed into law and fully funded, families may not need to worry about paying for student meals this next school year.

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Sheriff Dart Calls on Congress to Make 24/7 Carjacking Hotline National

Citing the urgent need to address the rise in violent carjackings across the country, Sheriff Thomas J. Dart called on Congress today to follow Illinois' lead and require automakers to create a quicker way for police and victims to access the location of hijacked vehicles. "Hijacked vehicles are often used to further additional violent crimes, including armed robbery and homicide, but we can find many of these cars quickly if automakers would remove unnecessary bureaucratic hurdles to providing critical location data," Sheriff Dart said. "Illinois lawmakers were right to overwhelmingly pass legislation to require automakers to create 24/7 hotlines to provide tracking information after a carjacking in a way that protects consumer privacy. The federal government can easily follow suit here, saving lives and limiting this vicious, violent crime that has left too many people afraid to drive." Resolutions have been introduced in the General Assembly by state Rep. Martin Moylan and state Sen. Willie Preston calling on Congress to help address carjackings and create a national hotline. Cook County saw 1,838 reported carjackings in 2022, up 24 percent from 2020. Meanwhile, data from the Council on Criminal Justice shows that the number of carjackings increased 24 percent across seven cities from 2020 to 2022. Those cities include Baltimore, Chicago, Denver, Los Angeles, Memphis, Norfolk, and San Francisco. Many vehicles built after 2015 have tracking capabilities, but legal access to that data is routinely delayed when automakers do not staff existing call centers afterhours, require victims to pay a service fee to activate tracking, or institute legally unnecessary hurdles. To demonstrate the issue, Sheriff Dart played audio



of a Sheriff Police Officer's interaction with Acura in trying to locate a 2020 Acura sedan carjacked at gunpoint

from an 85-year-old woman in the 4200 block of west Henderson Street on April 28.

El Alguacil Dart Pide al Congreso Haga Nacional 24/7 la Línea Directa de Robo de Auto

Citando la urgente necesidad de atender los violentos robos de autos en el país, el Sheriff Thomas J. Dart pidió al Congreso hoy que siga el ejemplo de Illinois y que exija a los fabricantes de automóviles que creen una forma más rápida para que la policía y las víctimas puedan tener la ubicación de los vehículos secuestrados. "Los vehículos robados son muchas veces utilizados para cometer más crímenes violentos, incluyendo el robo a mano armada y el homicidio, pero podríamos encontrar muchos de esos autos rápidamente si los fabricantes de automóviles eliminaran los obstáculos burocráticos innecesarios para dar los datos de ubicación indispensables", dijo el Alguacil Dart. Los legisladores de Illinois tenían razón de aprobar abrumadoramente la legislación para pedir que los legisladores pidan que los fabricantes creen líneas directas, 24 horas, siete días a la semana para dar información después del robo de un auto, de forma que se proteja la privacidad del consumidor. Fácilmente, el gobierno federal puede hacer lo mismo aquí, salvando vidas y limitando este crimen vicioso y violento que ha dejado a muchas personas con miedo de conducir". Las resoluciones fueron introducidas en la Asamblea

General por el Rep. Estatal Martín Moylan y el Sen. Estatal Willie Preston, pidiendo al Congreso que ayude a atender el robo de autos y cree una línea nacional directa. El condado de Cook vio 1,838 robos reportados en el 2022, un 24 por ciento más que en el 2020. Mientras tanto, datos del Concilio sobre Justicia Criminal muestran que el número de robos aumentó 24 por ciento en siete ciudades, del 2020 al 2022. Estas ciudades incluyen Baltimore, Chicago, Denver, Los Angeles, Memphis, Norfolk y San Francisco. Muchos vehículos construidos después del 2015 tienen capacidades para ser rastreados, pero el acceso legal a esos datos rutinariamente es demorado cuando los fabricantes de autos no tienen personal en los centros de llamadas después de horas de oficina y requieren que las víctimas paguen una cuota por el servicio para activar el rastreo o instituir legalmente los obstáculos innecesarios. Para demostrar el problema, el Alguacil Dart hizo oír un audio de la interacción del Funcionario de Policía del Alguacil con Acura tratando de localizar un sedán Acura 2020 robado a punta de pistola a una mujer de 85 años en la cuadra 4200 de W. Henderson St., el 28 de abril.

Las Escuelas Públicas de Chicago y los City Colleges de Chicago Celebran a Más de 600 Graduados de Doble Crédito

El CEO de las Escuelas Públicas de Chicago (CPS) Pedro Martínez, el Canciller de los City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) y administradores escolares y familias se reunieron para reconocer el creciente número de graduados de CPS que salen de la secundaria con un diploma y con créditos transferibles de universidad hasta e incluyendo un grado asociado. Aproximadamente 5,000 graduados de la Clase del 2023 de CPS obtuvieron cerca de 40,000 créditos totales de colegio de CCC estando todavía en la secundaria, ahorrando un estimado de \$5.8 millones en total en costos proyectados de colegiatura de colegio. La ceremonia del martes fue celebrada en el gimnasio de Malcolm X College, donde más de



600 alumnos de último año de secundaria de 69 CPS recibieron el cordón azul ceremonial, que puede usarse durante la ceremonia de graduación de un estudiante, por obtener 15 o más créditos de colegio durante su penúltimo y último año, el equivalente a un semestre de colegio. CPS y CCC comenzaron a ofrecer cursos tempranos de colegio, pidieron

también un crédito dual o una inscripción dual, hace más de una década y han continuado ampliando estas oportunidades en la ciudad mientras forman una afiliación única conocida como *The Chicago Roadmap*. La iniciativa ofrece acceso a programas de alta calidad, aconsejando y apoyando, exploración de carreras y preparación en un esfuerzo por aumentar

equitativamente los resultados estudiantiles en la inscripción universitaria, la obtención de títulos universitarios y empleo. CCC trabaja con maestros individuales de secundaria para asegurar que las lecciones cumplen con las normas de los cursos que se toman en el campus de CCC. Los cursos de inscripción dual son impartidos en los City Colleges of Chicago por la facultad de CCC.

Chicago Public Schools and City Colleges of Chicago Celebrate More than 600 Dual Credit Graduates

Chicago Public Schools (CPS) CEO Pedro Martínez, City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) Chancellor Juan Salgado, school administrators and families came together to recognize the growing number of CPS graduates who are leaving high school with a diploma as well as transferable college credits, up to and including an associate degree. Approximately 5,000 CPS Class of 2023 graduates earned nearly 40,000 total college credits from CCC while still in high school, saving an estimated \$5.8 million in total projected college tuition costs. Tuesday's ceremony was celebrated in the gym at Malcolm X College where more than 600 seniors from 69 CPS high schools received a ceremonial blue cord, which can be worn during a student's graduation ceremony, for earning 15 or more college credits during their junior and senior years, the equivalent of one semester in college. CPS and CCC began offering early college courses, also called dual credit or dual enrollment, more than a decade ago and have continued expanding these opportunities throughout the city while forming a unique partnership known as The Chicago Roadmap.
