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Board of Review Opens 2023 Tax Session



Cook County Board of Review Chairman George Cardenas gaveled in the Board's 2023 tax session opening Group 1 two months and 10 days earlier than the Board opened the 2022 tax session (November 21st) and three months before 2021's opening (December 6th). An earlier opening to the tax session is one of several initiatives the Board is taking to get bills out on time next year, in addition to implementation of the Tyler IASWorld Bridge and rearrangement of the Township appeal schedule in conjunction with CCAO.

The 2022 Cook County tax roll is scheduled to be certified September 1st. This year the Board will focus on helping Cook County residents who are victims of this summer's flooding to know their rights and apply for all County property tax assistance for which they are eligible. Chairman Cardenas, partnering with local governments, will be hosting workshops in Berwyn, Cicero and Riverside throughout August and September. Residents in Southern Cook County are seeing big changes in their

proposed assessments as they are reassessed this year. Multiple townships in the Southern Triennial Reassessment are seeing Assessed Value increases of more than 50 percent. The Board will be in those areas educating taxpayers about the appeal process. The Board will open 10 townships for appeal in September, with Calumet, Barrington, Norwood Park, Oak Park and Riverside opening September 11th in Group 1 and Berwyn, Cicero, Hanover, River Forest and Rogers Park Townships opening September 18th in Group 2.

USDA Recognizes VNA Health Care for Excellent Breastfeeding Support



Giannoulias Awards \$27 Million to Support Public Library Services and Literacy Efforts



In support of libraries, education and

lifelong learning, Illinois Secretary of State and

State Librarian Alexi Giannoulias announced

that he has awarded over \$21.4 million in grants for library services and over \$5.7 million in adult literacy grants for local literacy programs to more than 140 Illinois recipients. Giannoulias awarded the grants to projects that:

•Support educational mentoring programs that engage students in active learning.

•Fund online catalogs and

provide resources aimed at narrowing the digital divide.

•Provide educational and training opportunities for library staff.

•Train volunteers who tutor older teens and adults in basic reading, math, writing and language skills.
•Allow access to news and reading materials for those who are vision impaired or have other physical

limitations.

The Secretary of State's office awarded grants for library programs and services using combined state funds and federal Library Services and Technology Act funds. The Adult Literacy Program is funded with state funds and is administered by the Secretary of State's Illinois State Library Literacy Office.

Consultants (IBCLCs) and three Certified Lactation Specialists (CLSs) who desire to educate and support the breastfeeding moms of their community, the clinic has a current caseload of about 4,500 people in southern Kane County. In the third

quarter of 2023, 11.2 percent of infants served at VNA locations were exclusively breastfeeding infants, compared to the statewide average of 10.1 percent. Each year, the USDA recognizes organizations nationwide who have implemented,

or are in the process of implementing, exemplary processes in breastfeeding support and education with the goal of motivating local agencies to bolster their own programs in order to increase the rates of initiation and duration of breastfeeding among WIC participants.
