New Poll Shows Widespread Support for Healthy School Meals for All Illinois Students



Healthy School Meals for All Kids, a coalition dedicated to ensuring all Illinois students have access to free school meals, released a new poll showing strong support for providing free breakfast and lunch among voters. The poll found that funding free school meals in the Fiscal Year 2025 budget is the top priority for Illinois voters when compared with other legislative budget priorities proposed this session, with

a majority of respondents saying it was either their first or second funding choice. The poll found that funding free school meals for all students received the majority of support across Illinois and among all ages. Sixty-four percent of all Illinoisans support it, including 84% of those in the City of Chicago, 62% of those in the Collar counties, 56% of those downstate, and 74% of those between the ages of 18-44. Funding healthy

school meals for all kids receives bipartisan support, with 81% of Democrats, 55% of Independents, and 52% of Republicans. 60% of voters said they'd be more likely to vote for their legislator if they support funding the initiative. Eight other states, including neighboring Minnesota and Michigan, already have universal school meals. Additional states, including New Jersey and New York, are building up to it in the next few years. Food

insecurity is a problem facing communities all across Illinois – whether urban, suburban, or rural,

and making free school meals available to all students will help those in every corner of our state.

Una Nueva Encuesta Muestra un Apoyo Generalizado a las Comidas Escolares Saludables para todos los Estudiantes de Illinois

Healthy School Meals for All Kids, una coalición dedicada a garantizar que todos los estudiantes de Illinois tengan acceso a comidas escolares gratuitas, publicó una nueva encuesta que muestra un fuerte apoyo a proporcionar desayuno y almuerzo gratuitos entre los votantes. La encuesta encontró que financiar comidas escolares gratuitas en el presupuesto del año fiscal 2025 es la principal prioridad para los votantes de Illinois en comparación con otras prioridades presupuestarias legislativas propuestas en esta sesión, y la mayoría de los encuestados dijeron que era su primera o segunda opción de financiamiento. Cook County Department of Public Health Unveils New Graphic Novel Campaign



Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH) launched a fresh campaign to address an age-old problem: Explaining the role of public health in building healthier communities. Enter the Public Health Heroes

League campaign, featuring a diverse cast of fictional graphic novel characters rendered in saturated, vibrant color, to convey the story of how the health department works with the community to tackle real public health challenges

and prevent illnesses, injuries and deaths. Over the next couple months, the Public Health Heroes League will be “visiting locations near you,” on suburban Cook County buses, billboards, websites and social media sites. The

graphic narratives show the heroes fighting the opioid epidemic and tuberculosis, guarding against lead hazards, promoting immunizations, conducting community outreach and providing resources to schools. There will also be a series of three, 30-second animated videos. Episode 1, “Dawn of Vigilance,” introduces the league’s main characters – like

Community Engagement Specialist Nia Jackson, “empowering communities to take charge of their health,” Epidemiologist Dr. Tahira Al-Zahid, “unraveling health mysteries, keeping us steps ahead of diseases,” and Public Information Officer Gabriela Torres, “spreading the word, not the virus, to keep us informed and safe.” In Episode 2, “Smoke

Los Empleos de Nómina de Illinois Aumentan, la Tasa de Desempleo Aumenta Ligeramente en Febrero



El Departamento de Seguridad del Empleo de Illinois (IDES) anunció que la tasa de desempleo aumentó +0,1 puntos porcentuales hasta el 4,8 por ciento, mientras que las nóminas no agrícolas aumentaron +23.100 en febrero, según datos preliminares proporcionados por la Oficina de Estadísticas Laborales de EE.UU. (BLS) y publicados por

el IDES. La tasa de desempleo revisada de enero fue del 4,7 por ciento, sin cambios con respecto a la tasa de desempleo preliminar de enero. La variación mensual de las nóminas de enero se revisó con respecto al informe preliminar, de +1.700 a -900 puestos de trabajo. La tasa de desempleo de febrero y la estimación de empleos nómina reflejan la activi-

dad de la semana, incluido el día 12. En febrero, los sectores industriales con las mayores ganancias de empleo durante el mes incluyeron: Gobierno (+6.700), Construcción (+6.200) y Ocio y Hospitalidad (+5.400). Los sectores industriales con caídas mensuales de empleos en nómina incluyeron: Comercio, Transporte y Servicios Públicos (-1,900), Manufactura (-700) y Actividades Financieras (-600). La tasa de desempleo del estado fue +0,9 puntos porcentuales más alta que la tasa de desempleo nacional reportada en febrero. La tasa de desempleo nacional fue del 3,9 por ciento en febrero, +0,2 puntos porcentuales más que el mes anterior. La tasa de desempleo de Illinois aumentó +0,5 puntos porcentuales respecto al año anterior, cuando era del 4,3 por ciento.

City of Chicago Announces Return of Five Chicago Park District Facilities to Programming, Operations



Beginning March 30, 2024, the City of Chicago will “decompress” temporary shelters at five Chicago Park District facilities that are currently part of the New Arrivals Mission. After all shelter residents have been transitioned to another shelter, the Park District will begin the process of restoring the facilities and resuming park programming and other park operations at each of the five locations

currently used as temporary emergency shelters. Over the next several weeks, shelter residents from Gage Park, the Broadway Armory Park, Brands Park, Leone Park and Piotrowski Park will be transitioned to nearby shelters, minimizing disruptions with schooling and work. The Park District will then assess the facilities and undertake the work that may be needed to return them to their prior use, including

any necessary repairs and maintenance, returning any equipment that was stored elsewhere, and updating IT and program registration systems. City departments will work to ensure a smooth transition with the least disruption to shelter residents and the community as possible. This process will be followed by the Chicago Park District working to make its facilities ready for community use soon thereafter.

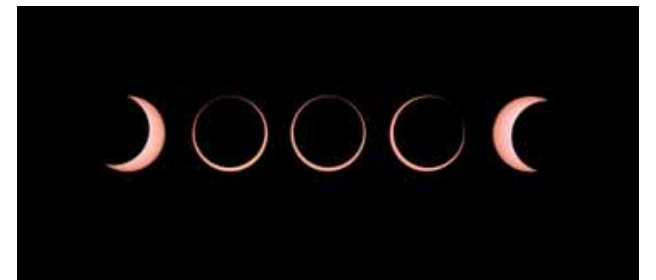

Column: Your Property Taxes with Cook County Treasurer Maria Pappas **Top 10 tips that help homeowners better understand their property taxes**

Homeowners have taught me a few things about property taxes while I have served as Cook County Treasurer. One lesson is that the property tax system is complicated. Many people unfamiliar with the process have told me that they wished there was a simpler, easier way to keep track of their property taxes and pay their bills. With that goal in mind, here are 10 tips for helping homeowners better understand their property taxes and potentially save money:

1.) Website. You can use cookcountytreasurer.com to pay your bill, check for available refunds, search a 20-year tax history of your property, discover how much debt taxing bodies owe and perform many other services.
2.) PIN. Your property has a specific 14-digit number that identifies it as unique from all the other 1.8 million parcels of land in Cook County. You need to know your Property Index Number, or PIN, and refer to it when paying your bill or contacting our office. Your PIN is printed on your tax bills and is listed on

your property's deed.

3.) Phone. Call our automated phone system at (312) 443-5100, any time, day or night, for helpful tax information such as verifying payments and checking for refunds. The phone system offers services in English, Spanish and Polish.

4.) Payment locations. You can conveniently pay your property tax bill in person at more than 400 Chase Bank locations throughout Chicago and at more than 160 community bank locations.

5.) Avoid duplicate payment. When you buy or sell a home or refinance a mortgage, check to ensure that there are no duplicate property tax payments. Often, representatives of a buyer and seller both pay a tax bill, or two members of a household may both pay a tax bill by mistake.

6.) Mortgage escrow. If you pay your taxes through a mortgage escrow account, verify that your tax bill is paid on time and on the correct PIN.

7.) Exemptions. Be sure to receive all exemptions for which you are eligible. Homeowner, senior citizen and senior freeze are the most common exemptions,

which are substantial tax breaks that lower tax bills. Visit cookcountytreasurer.com to learn more.

8.) Refunds. Discover whether you are eligible for up to \$150 million in potential refunds owed to Cook County property owners because of overpayments going back 20 years or missed exemptions for the past four years. Visit cookcountytreasurer.com to find out if you are owed a refund and to apply online. There is no need to have a third party file for you.

9.) Pappas Studies. Read our latest study, "The Few Decide for the Many: Referendums and Voter Turnout," that showed how a relatively small number of voters often decide taxation and spending questions that affect an entire community. Additional studies have analyzed tax bills, redlining, debt by taxing bodies and other topics.

10.) Name/Address change. Notify us of any changes in your name or mailing address at cookcountytreasurer.com. You can also sign up for eBilling to go paperless and receive your next tax bill via email.

Obama Foundation Releases New Facility Details

The Obama Foundation released new details for their Obama Presidential Center. Nestled at the southwest corner of the 19.3-acre Obama Presidential Center in Jackson Park, the Home Court – the largest gathering space on the campus – will serve as a place for health and wellness activities, events, and a wide range of opportunities for community engagement. As a 45,000 square-foot multipurpose athletic and events space, the Home Court features a gymnasium with a

regulation-size NBA court with intersecting practice courts, flexible seating, exercise training space, and fitness equipment. This space will accommodate everything from enriching basketball and other sports programs to large events and formal banquets. The facility is being built by Elevate Design Builders, a joint firm led by Bowa Construction, an African American-owned construction management firm headquartered in Chicago on South Stony Island, and AECOM/Hunt. To inform programming

needs on site, the Foundation is working with local community organizations including the YMCA, XS Tennis, Project Swish, Southside Wolfpack, Girls in the Game, and After School Matters to gather suggestions on programming that will be additive and complementary to opportunities already provided to young people in the community. St. Bede School in Ingleside to Close Despite Massive Fundraising

Rev. George Koeune, pastor of Our Lady of the Lakes Parish and St. Bede School in Ingleside, Ill. announced that St. Bede School will be closing at the end of this school year due to low registration for next school year. As of March 19, 119 students had registered for next year whereas the parish and school had set an enrollment target of 182. The plight of St. Bede School became widely known earlier this winter when the parish and school launched a fundraising campaign to keep the school open. Over \$500,000 was raised through that campaign but, in the end, not enough students enrolled to make the school viable. Koeune and the parish finance council met the evening of March 19 and agreed that the appropriate action was to close the school. Cardinal Blase



J. Cupich, archbishop of Chicago, accepted their recommendation. St. Bede School is in Ingleside, Ill. in rural Lake County. It serves a mix of white and Hispanic families and its

current enrollment is 182. Families who receive an Invest in Kids scholarship for students to attend a nonpublic school must meet income eligibility requirements.

Illinois Payroll Jobs Increase, Unemployment Rate Up Slightly in February



The Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) announced that the unemployment rate increased +0.1 percentage point to 4.8 percent, while nonfarm payrolls increased +23,100 in February, based on preliminary data provided by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), and released by IDES. The January revised

unemployment rate was 4.7 percent, unchanged from the preliminary January unemployment rate. The January monthly change in payrolls was revised from the preliminary report, from +1,700 to -900 jobs. The February unemployment rate and payroll jobs estimate reflect activity for the week including the 12th.

In February, the industry sectors with the largest over-the-month job gains included: Government (+6,700), Construction (+6,200), and Leisure and Hospitality (+5,400). The industry sectors with monthly payroll job declines included: Trade, Transportation and Utilities (-1,900), Manufacturing (-700), and Financial Activities (-600). The state's unemployment rate was +0.9 percentage point higher than the national unemployment rate reported for February. The national unemployment rate was 3.9 percent in February, up +0.2 percentage point from the previous month. The Illinois unemployment rate was up +0.5 percentage point from a year ago when it was 4.3 percent.
