




Opening of First Ever Ferrero Chocolate Factory in North America

On Tuesday, Governor JB Pritzker joined the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, local stakeholders, and Ferrero North America leadership to celebrate the grand opening of the continent's first Ferrero chocolate factory in Bloomington, Illinois. The 70,000 square-foot expansion to Ferrero's manufacturing campus in Bloomington will produce chocolate

used in iconic products like Kinder®. Ferrero Rocher®, Butterfinger®, and CRUNCH®. The facility is the company's first chocolate processing plant in North America and third globally. Governor Pritzker joined the Ferrero North America team three years ago to break ground on the new facility, and the construction was completed this year. This \$75 million investment from Ferrero builds on the company's

continued impact in Illinois. In 2018. Ferrero took over management of a manufacturing plant in Franklin Park, Illinois, where they focus on Butterfinger and Baby Ruth products. The company also manufactures Keebler products at a plant located on 110th street in Chicago. In 2023, Ferrero opened an Innovation Center and R&D Lab in Chicago's Marshall Field Company Building.



ICC Shares Smart Tips for Consumers Ahead of Spring Moving Season



With peak moving season starting in Illinois,

the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) is urging residents to research moving companies before

packing any boxes. "A quick online search or call to the ICC can go a long way toward protecting residents from falling victim to moving scams", said ICC's Chief of Police Ruben Ramirez. "Spring is a popular time to move, but unfortunately, this also can mean an uptick in predatory or rouge movers. The ICC offers resources to help Illinoisans vet potential movers and avoid the financial and emotional toll of a move gone wrong." Intrastate moving companies in Illinois must be licensed with the ICC. Consumers can check to see if an intrastate household goods mover is properly licensed to operate in Illinois and view the number of complaints filed against each company on the ICC website. This information

can also be obtained by calling 217-782-6448. If residents are moving to another state, the mover must be licensed by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. Thee ICC's Smart Tips for hiring a mover include:

•Check to see if the moving company is licensed by the ICC to operate in Illinois.

•Do not rely on mobile apps alone to select and schedule your movers.

•Ask the mover to visit your home. If you can,

show them the contents of every room, closet, garage, etc. you want moved, and talk about what they can expect at the new home.

•Request a written estimate. A written quote is not binding, but it will give you a reasonable expectation of what you'll be required to pay on moving day.

•Discuss your options for loss and damage protection. Get it in writing.


