State Rep. Hernandez is highlighting free, one-on-one online support that ISAC is offering for students and families navigating the FAFSA application process. Cook County property owners have a free financial planning tool that can help them pay off their past-due property tax bills and avoid the “merciless” Annual Tax Sale, Treasurer Maria Pappas said Monday. A Payment Plan Calculator at cookcountytreasurer.com is available at no cost to help property owners who are late paying their taxes. The calculator assists taxpayers who want to budget their property tax expenses over payments made monthly or every two weeks. While the Treasurer’s Office has previously accepted

partial tax bill payments, the calculator is designed to provide an actual system for those at risk of having their past-due taxes sold at the county’s Annual Tax Sale, an auction of unpaid property taxes. Many homeowners were shocked by property tax increases this year, particularly in the south and southwest suburbs. They worry what will happen if they are unable to pay their bills in full by the Thursday, Aug. 1 due date. Taxpayers may sign up to receive email or text message notifications reminding them to make

the monthly or biweekly payments recommended by the Payment Plan Calculator. State law requires that property owners who do not pay their taxes in full by the due date face additional interest charges of 0.75 percent per month, effective with 2023 taxes due in 2024. Late taxes that were due in 2023 and earlier years are charged interest of 1.5 percent per month. A video tutorial is available at cookcountytreasurer.com to walk taxpayers through the steps of using the Payment Plan Calculator.

Promoting Cultural Awareness with By The Hand Club For Kids

Sweltering heat could not deter the students at By The Hand Club for Kids who walked along the 26th Street Corridor to take in all the historical sites, food, music, and the cultural significance of Little Village. By The Hand Club for Kids is a non-profit organization “Christ-centered” after-school program that helps children who live in under-resources neighborhoods. This summer, high school students spent six weeks visiting neighborhoods, such as Chinatown, Humboldt Park, Little Village, Little Saigon as part of cultural awareness and sensitivity program while gaining hands-on instruction in documentary filmmaking. The organization’s goal is to instill in Chicago youth an appreciation of the city’s diversity and to build the

2017-2011” es solo el segundo informe sobre la mortalidad de personas sin hogar realizado por un gobierno estatal, después del Informe de Mortalidad por Falta de vivienda de Minnesota de 2023. El informe, que se basa en registros hospitalarios y certificados de defunción de todo el estado, se desarrolló como parte de un esfuerzo continuo de varias agencias por parte del gobierno del estado de Illinois para promover el acceso y la estabilidad de la vivienda en todo el estado. Este esfuerzo es conducido por la Oficina para Prevenir y Terminar la Falta de Vivienda (OPEH), que trabaja con IDPH y otras agencias estatales a través del Grupo Especial de la Inter-agencia de Illinois sobre el Desamparo, para profundizar estrategias para prevenir y terminar

el desamparo. El informe destaca el alcance de los problemas de salud que afectan de manera desproporcionada a las personas sin hogar y la necesidad de aumentar las intervenciones destinadas a promover la salud. Entre las conclusiones del informe se incluyen las siguientes:

- Por el período de tiempo cubierto en el reporte, la edad promedio al momento de muerte fue de cerca de 20 años más joven para la gente que tenía falta de vivienda (PEH) que la población en general, 56.3 contra 74.2 años.
- Ha habido un aumento general de 36.6 por ciento en muertes de personas que experimentan falta de vivienda desde el principio de la pandemia del COVID, mientras que ha habido solo un 6.1 por ciento de aumento en muertes de la

población en general en el mismo período de tiempo, después de tener en cuenta las tres olas de COVID en ambos grupos.

• El aumento en muertes desde el principio de la pandemia del COVID parece ser en parte por un aumento en sobredosis relacionadas con las drogas (proporción de muertes pre-vs post- COVID; 27.1 por ciento vs 33.2 por ciento).

• Las personas con EPH corrían un mayor riesgo de ser agredidas y tenían casi tres veces más probabilidades de morir por homicidio que la población general, un 2,9 por ciento en comparación con un 1 por ciento.




