Las inseguridades de la economía y la violencia aguí v en todo el país, etc., han hecho que Nuestra Bendita Madre venga a nosotros para cumplir su palabra: 'para dar a todos los que confian en mí, todo mi amor, protección y refugio."

La Sagrada escultura, de tamaño natural de la Virgen Peregrina llegará al Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, 1170 N. River Rd., esta semana como parte de su gira espiritual. La visita es parte de la celebración del 500° aniversario de las apariciones del Tepeyac. Habrá también

una exhibición gratuita con dos reproducciones digitales de la imagen original de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, una de San Juan Diego y la escultura tamaño natural creada por el artista mexicano Jorge Ismael Rodríguez. La instalación incluve música original y reflexiones narradas que reviven la historia de las apariciones del Tepeyac. "Esto es un símbolo de paz unidad y la renovación de la fé", dijo Monseñor Diego Monroy, Rector Interino de la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. "Invitamos a todos a que vengan y regresen a la iglesia, especialmente las generaciones jóvenes distraídas por la tecnología, donde se ha perdido un sentido de comunidad. Life-Size Sculpture of Pilgrim Mother, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Begins Journey in Chicago

Beginning this week, people will have the opportunity to see a holy statue from Mexico here in the Chicago area. The life-sized Pilgrim Mother, Our Lady of Guadalupe statue normally resides in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City, but now it's going on an international tour. "We are incredibly honored that Chicago is the first stop on this national tour," said Revered Esequiel Sanchez, Rector, Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe during a press conference on Monday. "In these difficult times, when

our trust has been shattered, and many feel threatened by the insecurities our people are experiencing due to the deportation operations taking place in countries around the world. The insecurities of the economy and violence here and across the country, etc., which is why Our Blessed Mother comes to us to fulfill her word: 'to give all who trust in me, all my love protection, and shelter."

The life-sized, holy sculpture of the Pilgrim Mother will arrive at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, 1170 N. River Rd., this week as part of

the spiritual tour. The visit is part of the observance of the 500th anniversary of the apparitions at Tepevac. There will also be a free exhibit featuring two digital reproductions of the original image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, one of St. Juan Diego, and the life-sized sculpture created by Mexican artist Jorge Ismael Rodríguez. The installation includes original music and narrated reflections that bring to life the story of the apparitions at Tepeyac. "This is a symbol of peace, unity, and the renewal of faith," said Monsignor Diego Monroy,

of Our Lady of Guadalupe. "We invite all to come and return to the church, especially the younger generation that is distracted by technology, where a sense of community has been lost. We invite them to come and seek a reconnection."

The sculpture will remain in the Shrine until September 30th. Following that visit, it will be moved to St. Gall Parish in Chicago, at 5511 Sawyer Ave., where it will be on display from October 1st through 14th. After that,



Rep. Delgado Plan to Lower Student Loan Interest Rates Signed into Law

As students and recent graduates continue to face rising costs, a measure to lower student loan interest rates sponsored by state Rep. Eva-Dina Delgado, D-Chicago, was signed into law last Friday. The bill combines student loan interests into a lower, fixed rate by empowering the State Treasurer to refinance student loans. "As the federal government makes it harder than ever for college students to become debt free, here in Illinois we are making every effort possible to lower student loan debt and set college graduates on a path to a freer financial future," Delgado said. "My measure to consolidate student loans of varying interest rates and levels into a fixed, lower rate will not only make it easier for our students to track how many loans



they have but also will lower their overall financial burden considerably." Delgado passed House Bill 1430 which authorizes the State Treasurer to use the Student Investment Account to refinance student loans. When refinancing an individual's multiple student loans, an

Your Property Taxes with Cook County Treasurer Maria Pappas

Don't Pay for What You Can Get for Free: How to Claim Your Property Tax Refunds

Every year, many Cook County homeowners are bombarded with letters, emails and phone calls from vendors offering to help secure property tax refunds — for a fee. But here's the truth: You don't need to pay anyone to get money that's already yours. My office has \$122 million in potential refunds available from overpayments going back 20 vears. In addition, more than \$33 million in refunds may be available to homeowners who missed exemptions in the last four years. Applying is simple, free and secure and you keep every dollar of your refund, taxfree. To get started, visit cookcountytreasurer.com. On the homepage, look for the purple box labeled Your Property Tax Overview and click on it. You'll be asked to enter your 14-digit Property Index Number (PIN). If you don't know your PIN, use your property address just enter the house number, street name, city, and zip

A photo of your property will appear. Click the words View Your Property Tax Information to get details about your property and its tax history. Scroll down the page until you reach the section titled "Are There Any Overpayments on Your PIN?" If you're eligible for a refund, you'll see red text indicating the amount available and the year the overpayment occurred. It will say "Refund Available, Application Required, Apply Now." Click "Apply Now" and an application will open with several sections already filled in.

You'll be asked to confirm or provide a phone number and email address, and to certify that you're entitled to the refund. On the following screen, you'll have the option to upload any proof of payment you may have, especially helpful if the property changed hands. After submitting the application, your refund should arrive within six

to eight weeks. While checking for overpayments, you should also review whether you've missed any exemptions in recent years. Just below the overpayment section, you'll see a grid titled "Have You Received Your Exemptions in These Tax Years?" This tool will show you whether vou have received the Homeowner, Senior Citizen, Senior Freeze, or any other exemptions. If you have missed one or more, you may be owed hundreds or even thousands of dollars - and you can apply for a refund for missed exemptions going back four years right there on the site._That's all it takes. No lawyers, no middlemen, no fees. Just a few minutes online, and you could recover money that belongs to you. It's your refund. Don't give a dime of it away. Take five minutes — and take back what's rightfully yours.

Missing Persons Identification Act Becomes Law

Legislation championed by Cook County Sheriff Thomas J. Dart that creates new guidelines for missing persons investigations is now state law. SB 24, the Missing Persons Identification Act, sponsored by Sen. Michael Hastings in the Senate and Rep. Debbie Meyers-Martin in the House, will require law enforcement to:

- Immediately take a report when they are notified of a missing person and enter it into the Law Enforcement Agencies Data System (LEADS).
- Eliminate the practice of observing a waiting period before taking a missing persons report.
- Collect existing fingerprint records, dental records,



photographs, and other biometrics for purposes of publishing the information in the National Missing and Unidentified Persons System (NamUs), a federal database, if the person remains missing for 60 days.

• Collect fingerprint records of the missing person and search them against all available repositories at the local, state, and national levels. This is opposed to only searching local criminal databases which limits results to those who have been involved in the criminal justice system.

 Keep missing persons cases active with their agency, and in all applicable databases, until the person returns or is located.

The bill's guidelines draw Sheriff's from Police detectives' experiences and skill sets from reopening the John Wayne Gacy serial killings to identify the unidentified victims. After re-opening the investigation in 2011, detectives saw firsthand how often missing person cases were incomplete or overlooked. Detectives continuing to see similar patterns in current missing person cases, as well as outcry from the community that these cases were receiving inefficient attention, led to Sheriff Dart forming the Missing Persons Project in 2021. This unit uses all contemporary investigative and forensic methods, tools, and databases, including NamUs, to locate missing women. To date, the unit has closed more than 40 cases. Governor JB Pritzker signed the bill into law on Aug. 15. It will go into effect Jan. 1, 2026.

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Governor Pritzker Signs Landmark Bill to Ensure Campus Access to Medication Abortion and Contraception

This morning, Governor J.B. Pritzker signed H.B. 3709, a groundbreaking law that makes Illinois the first state in the Midwest to guarantee that students at public colleges and universities can access medication abortion and contraception through campus health services. The law takes effect immediately, but the student access requirement applies beginning with the 2025–2026 school year. Under H.B. 3709, public colleges and universities must provide access through student health centers, telehealth, or licensed external providers; and if a campus has a pharmacy, that pharmacy must dispense prescribed contraception and (where applicable) medication

abortion. The signing of H.B. 3709 comes at a critical moment, as young people across the country continue to face mounting restrictions on abortion access, especially in states where campus health centers are barred from providing care. Illinois now joins a small but growing number of states ensuring students can access abortion care where they live and learn. California was the first to enact a campus medication abortion law in 2019, with implementation beginning in 2023. Massachusetts followed in 2022, and New York in 2023. Despite these wins, awareness of services remains low, making strong implementation and outreach in Illinois essential



El Gob. Pritzker Firma un Proyecto Histórico Garantizando el Acceso a Estudiantes a Medicamentos para el Aborto y la Anticoncepción



Esta mañana, el Gobernador J. B. Pritzker firmó el proyecto de Ley H.B. 3709, ley innovadora que convierte a Illinois en el primer estado del Medio Oeste en garantizar que los estudiantes de colegios y universidades públicas puedan acceder al aborto con medicamentos y a la anticoncepción a través del servicio de salud del campus. La ley entra en efecto inmediatamente, pero el requisito de acceso de estudiantes se aplica a partir del año escolar 2025-2026. Bajo el proyecto H.B. 3709, los colegios y universidades públicos deben brindar acceso a través de los centros de salud estudiantiles, tele-health o proveedores externos licenciados; y si un campus tiene una farmacia, esa farmacia debe dar una receta de anticoncepción y (donde sea aplicable) medicina para

aborto. La firma del Proyecto H.B. 3709 llega en un momento crítico ya que los jóvenes del país continúan enfrentando cada vez más restricciones para el acceso al aborto, especialmente en estados donde los centros de salud del campus tienen prohibido dar ese servicio. Illinois se une a un pequeño, pero creciente número de estados que garantiza que los estudiantes tienen acceso a atención de aborto donde viven y aprenden. California fue el primero en promulgar una lev de aborto con medicamentos en el campus en 2019, y su implementación comenzó en 2023. Massachusetts le siguió en 2022 y Nueva York en 2023. A pesar de estos logros, el conocimiento de los servicios sigue siendo bajo, lo que hace que una sólida implementación y difusión en Illinois sea esencial.
