## Giannoulias Unveils Relocated and Reimagined Lombard DMV

One of the state's busiest DMVs has relocated and is now offering 24-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week renewal services through the state's first drive-through DMV kiosk. The new facility uses a data-driven design to cut

wait times and improve the overall customer experience, Illinois Secretary of State Alexi Giannoulias announced. The state's west-suburban Lombard DMV re-opened this week at its new location, 837 Westmore-

Meyers Road, Unit A2, conveniently located in Eastgate Center, the same shopping center as the former location. For years, the Lombard facility has been one of the state's busiest facilities. The new location will include the

following amenities:

- **24/7 DMV Services.** The facility will offer a drive-through kiosk, the first of its kind in the state. This provides motorists 24-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week access to renew vehicle registrations,

obtain license plate stickers and renew their driver's licenses – even outside of normal business hours.

- **Cross-Trained Employees.** The Lombard DMV is among the first facilities in the Chicago area constructed as a "One-Stop-Shop." Driver services and vehicle services employees at "One-Stop-Shop" DMVs are cross-trained to provide both sets of services at all 30 customer stations.
- **Fewer Steps.** Each of the 30 customer service stations is equipped with a payment station, compared to just five at the old location, so customers no longer need to visit multiple stations and encounter waits.
- **Bigger Space.** At 13,600

square feet, the new facility is 1,600 square feet larger than the former DMV. More space coupled with the fact that all employees can service drivers and vehicle transactions will reduce lines and waits.

- **Administrative Hearings.** The DMV will conduct reinstatement hearings to decide cases involving driver's licenses suspended for driving-related offenses, including driving without insurance, driving under the influence, or having too many traffic violations.

• **Charging Stations.** The Secretary of State's office will offer 18 EV charging stations for customers beginning in 2025.

## Village of Rosemont Extends Naming Rights Partnership with Allstate

Its ever-expanding lineup of renowned artists and entertainers attract more

than a million visitors annually. Additionally, the Arena is home to the Chicago Wolves, one of the most decorated franchises in the AHL and the 2022 Calder Cup champions. The multi-purpose venue is operated by the Village of Rosemont and has established itself as a place where everyone can enjoy quality family shows, riveting sports and mesmerizing musical performances. ## Reps. García and Grijalva Demand Answers from DHS on Use of AI in Immigration Decision-Making

Representatives Jesús "Chuy" García (IL-04) and Raúl M. Grijalva (AZ-07) sent a letter to Secretary of Homeland Security Alejandro Mayorkas, Chief Information Officer Eric Hysen, and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Director Shalanda Young regarding the lack of transparency in the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) technologies by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and its subagencies. According to a recent report by Futures Law and Mijente,

DHS has been using AI technologies to inform critical decisions including whether to deport, detain and separate families, grant citizenship, and whether to protect someone from persecution, without proper regulation or notification of the impacted individuals. In October of 2023, President Biden issued Executive Order 14110, which established new standards for AI safety and security for federal agencies. Similarly, OMB issued a March 2024 memo "Advancing

Governance, Innovation, and Risk Management for Agency Use of Artificial Intelligence," which directs federal agencies to advance AI governance and innovation while managing risks to the rights and safety of the public. OMB has since declared that agencies must align their AI tools with the guidelines by December 1, and that any extensions or waivers of that deadline will be publicly disclosed this month. The letter requests answers on how DHS and immigration agencies are



ensuring migrants receive a fair and non-biased review of their applications and what safeguards are in place to prevent unjustified denials.

## Los Representantes García y Grijalva Exigen Respuestas de DHS Sobre el Uso de la Inteligencia Artificial en la Toma de Decisiones Sobre Inmigración

Los Representantes Jesús "Chuy" García (IL-04) y Raúl M. Grijalva (AZ-07) enviaron una carta al Secretario de Seguridad en el País, Alejandro Mayorkas, al Funcionario de Información en Jefe, Eric Hysen, y a la Directora de la Oficina de Gestión y Presupuesto, (OMB), Shalanda Young, sobre la falta de transparencia en el uso de tecnologías de Inteligencia Artificial (IA) por el Departamento de Seguridad en el País, (DHS) y sus sub-agencias. De acuerdo a un reciente reporte de Futures Law and Mijente, DHS ha estado usando tecnología de inteligencia artificial para informar decisiones críticas, incluyendo si se deporta, detiene o separa familias, se concede la ciudadanía y si se protege a alguien de persecución sin la apropiada regulación de notificación a los individuos impactados. En octubre de 2023, el Presidente Biden expidió la Orden Ejecutiva 14110, que estableció nuevas normas para la seguridad de la inteligencia artificial para las agencias federales. Igualmente, OMB expidió



un memo en marzo 2024 "Avanzando en Gobernanza, Innovación y Gestión de Riesgos para que la Agencia Utilice la Inteligencia Artificial" que ordena a las agencias federales promover la gobernanza y la innovación en materia

de IA y, al mismo tiempo, gestiona los riesgos para los derechos y la seguridad del público. OMB ha declarado desde entonces que las agencias deben alinear todas sus herramientas con las guías del 1º de diciembre y que cu-

alquier extensión o exención de ese plazo se dará a conocer públicamente este mes. La carta solicita

respuestas sobre cómo DHS y las agencias de inmigración garantizan que los migrantes reciban una


revisión justa e imparcial de sus solicitudes y qué salvaguardas existen para evitar negaciones injustificadas.

Chicago Mayor Brandon Johnson and Chicago-born musician, actor and philanthropist Vic Mensa joined the Metropolitan Peace Initiatives (MPI) and Communities Partnering 4 Peace (CP4P) Thursday night as they celebrated the newest round of Chicago community violence intervention (CVI) graduates from the Metropolitan Peace Academy (MPA). The MPA is the Metropolitan Peace Initiative's premier multi-disciplinary training program designed to provide skill building and professional development to the individuals who support the field of community violence intervention (CVI). The Academy provides intensive and robust gun violence prevention training for street outreach



workers, case managers, victim advocates, trauma recovery specialists and Chicago police officers. Mensa served as keynote speaker. Relaying a message of peace, he urged attendees and graduates alike to embrace love

and hope, despite facing systemic and personal challenges. "I'm grateful to be recognized for this commitment to fostering true, healthy communities," said Mayor Johnson. "Of course, I cannot do this work alone. I accept this

alongside the entire city of Chicago, including you all. You all in this room are activating a mission to ultimately build a better, stronger and safer future for posterity." To date, over 550 individuals have graduated from the MPA.

## Advocates, Educators Call on Illinois to Restore Monetary Award Program for Incarcerated Students

Following the bipartisan reinstatement of Pell Grant access to incarcerated people which was signed into law in 2020 and went into effect this year, Illinois' Back on the MAP campaign is pushing the state to restore Monetary Award Program (MAP) eligibility to people in prison by passing HB3740. The legislation sailed through the IL House and is waiting to be acted upon in the Senate. Now, more than half of states have ended state level bans on financial aid for incarcerated students, sending a clear political endorsement of the value of college-in-prison, signaling to Illinois that it is past time to also restore MAP. Providing college opportunities in prison has been found to deliver strong employment outcomes, develop employer-demanded skills, make prisons safer, and strengthen pathways to successful reentry. These programs also

hold the unique potential to improve students' lives, help narrow racial and economic equity gaps in postsecondary attainment and workforce participation, strengthen local economies and communities, and disrupt cycles of incarceration. In 2021, the Illinois legislature created a Task Force for Higher Education in Prison, which included practitioners of college-in-prison, community stakeholders, and directly impacted people from within and outside the state. The Task Force produced a report in 2022 with a series of recommendations for Illinois to better support college opportunities in prison. One of the key recommendations was the restoration of the MAP funding to incarcerated students. Representative Carol Ammons introduced House Bill 3740 in 2023 which removes the ban on Illinois need-based student aid for incarcerated people.

men and women students to succeed both in college and beyond. Launched in 2015 with TRIUMPH for men of color and expanded in 2017 with SURGE for women of color, the two programs combined in 2023 to create a more inclusive community. Today, TRIUMPH & SURGE welcomes all Triton College students, including those from the General Education Development (GED) and Workforce Equity Initiative (WEI) programs. ## Pritzker Administration Announces New Medicaid Coverage for Certified Doula and Lactation Consultant Services

New perinatal doula and lactation consultant services are now available to pregnant and postpartum individuals who are enrolled in the Illinois Medicaid program, further expanding maternal and child health coverage, a core priority for the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS). Certified doulas are trained professionals who provide a range of physical, educational and emotional supports to pregnant and birthing individuals throughout their pregnancy, birth and postpartum experience with a goal of improving health outcomes for birthing people and infants. Lactation consultants are healthcare professionals who provide breastfeeding education and support and can assist parents with any questions or challenges with breastfeeding. The coverage for certified doula services includes the entire perinatal period and up to one year postpartum,

regardless of how the pregnancy ends. Covered doula services include perinatal counseling, education and supports, including newborn care; development of a birth plan and support during labor and delivery; care coordination with available community-based services; attendance at clinician visits; emotional and physical support; and visits to assist with basic infant care. To enroll as an Illinois Medicaid provider, lactation consultants must be at least 18 years old and

certified as an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant (IBCLC) by the International Board of Lactation Consultant Examiners, certified as a Certified Lactation Counselor (CLC) by the Academy of Lactation Policy and Practice, Inc., or certified as a Certified Lactation Specialist (CLS) by the Lactation Education Consultants. 
Los nuevos servicios de doula perinatal y consultora de lactancia ahora están disponibles para las personas embarazadas y en posparto que están inscritas en el programa Medicaid de Illinois, lo que amplía aún más la cobertura de salud materna e infantil, una prioridad central para el Departamento de Atención Médica y Servi-

cios Familiares de Illinois (HFS). Las doulas certificadas son profesionales capacitadas que brindan una variedad de apoyos físicos, educativos y emocionales a las personas embarazadas y en proceso de parto durante su experiencia de embarazo, parto y posparto con el objetivo de mejorar los resultados de salud de las personas que dan a luz

y los bebés. Los consultores de lactancia son profesionales de la salud que brindan educación y apoyo sobre la lactancia materna y pueden ayudar a los padres con cualquier pregunta o desafío con la lactancia materna. La cobertura de los servicios de doula certificada incluye todo el período perinatal y hasta un año después del parto, independientemente de cómo termine el embarazo. Los servicios de doula cubiertos incluyen asesoramiento, educación y apoyo perinatal, incluido el cuidado del recién nacido; desarrollo de un plan de parto y apoyo durante el trabajo de parto y el parto; coordinación de la atención con los servicios comunitarios disponibles; asistencia a las visitas del médico; apoyo emocional



y físico; y visitas para ayudar con el cuidado básico del bebé. Para inscribirse como proveedor de Medicaid de Illinois, los consultores de lactancia deben tener al menos 18 años y estar certificados como Consultores de Lactancia Certificados por la Junta Internacional (IBCLC) por la Junta Internacional de Examinadores de Consultores de Lactancia, certificados como Especialistas en Lactancia Certificados (CLS) por los Consultores de Educación en Lactancia.
