De acuerdo a Chicago Health Atlas, 29 por ciento de los residentes de Chicago viven en la pobreza y cerca de 1 de cada 5 no tienen seguro de salud. Una meta de la clínica de CommunityHealth y microsítios es bajar esta disparidad. Esta nueva clínica de microsítios ofrecerá una variedad de servicios de salud esenciales, incluyendo visitas al doctor, trabajo de laboratorio, recogida de medicamentos y referencias al dentista y cuidado especial a adultos sin seguro o con un seguro deficiente, en el vecindario.

Esta ampliación es una afiliación entre CommunityHealth y The Resurrection Project, organización de impacto social dedicada a crear propiedad comunitaria, generar riqueza y brindar recursos a los vecindarios del suroeste de Chicago. Estamos profundamente comprometidos a proveer servicios indispensables a las familias de las comunidades a quienes servimos. Brindar cuidado de salud a través de nuestra afiliación con CommunityHealth, especialmente a los más vulnerables, es indispensable para el

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Free Health Clinic Opens in Back of the Yards

A free health clinic opened its doors in the Back-of-the-Yards neighborhood this week. CommunityHealth, the nation's largest volunteer-based free health center, opened its fourth location, CommunityHealth at The Resurrection Project (TRP), on March 17th. The new clinic is located at TRP's Casa Hidalgo, 4600 S. Wood St., location in the Back-of-the-Yards neighborhood.

"We are rethinking space and place for point of care to ensure that every Chicago resident has a door to access high-quality health care closer to home. CommunityHealth is proud to partner with The Resurrection Project, who provide not only essential resources, but also a critical voice, for the community we both serve," CommunityHealth CEO Steph Willding said.

According to Chicago Health Atlas, 29 percent of Chicago residents are living in poverty, and nearly 1 in 5 do not have health insurance. A goal of CommunityHealth's clinic and microsites is to lower this disparity. This new microsite clinic will offer a variety of essential healthcare services, including doctor visits, lab work, medication pickup, and referrals to dental and specialty care to uninsured and underinsured adults in the neighborhood.

This expansion is a partnership between CommunityHealth and The Resurrection Project, a social impact organization dedicated to creating community ownership, building wealth, and providing resources to Chicago's southwest neighborhoods. "We are deeply committed to providing critical services to families in the communities we serve.

Providing healthcare through our partnership with CommunityHealth, especially to the most vulnerable, is critical to the well-being of the Back of the Yards neighborhood." said Raul I. Raymundo, CEO and Co-Founder of The Resurrection Project. "This partnership reflects the mission of both organizations committed to investing in the health of families and communities across the city."

The opening of this new microsite is part of CommunityHealth's ongoing commitment to improving health equity and access to care in Chicago. "I am really happy to be here today for this collaboration between CommunityHealth and The Resurrection Project. I say that not just as an elected official for the district, but as a former patient of CommunityHealth and a daughter of a woman who worked for a very long

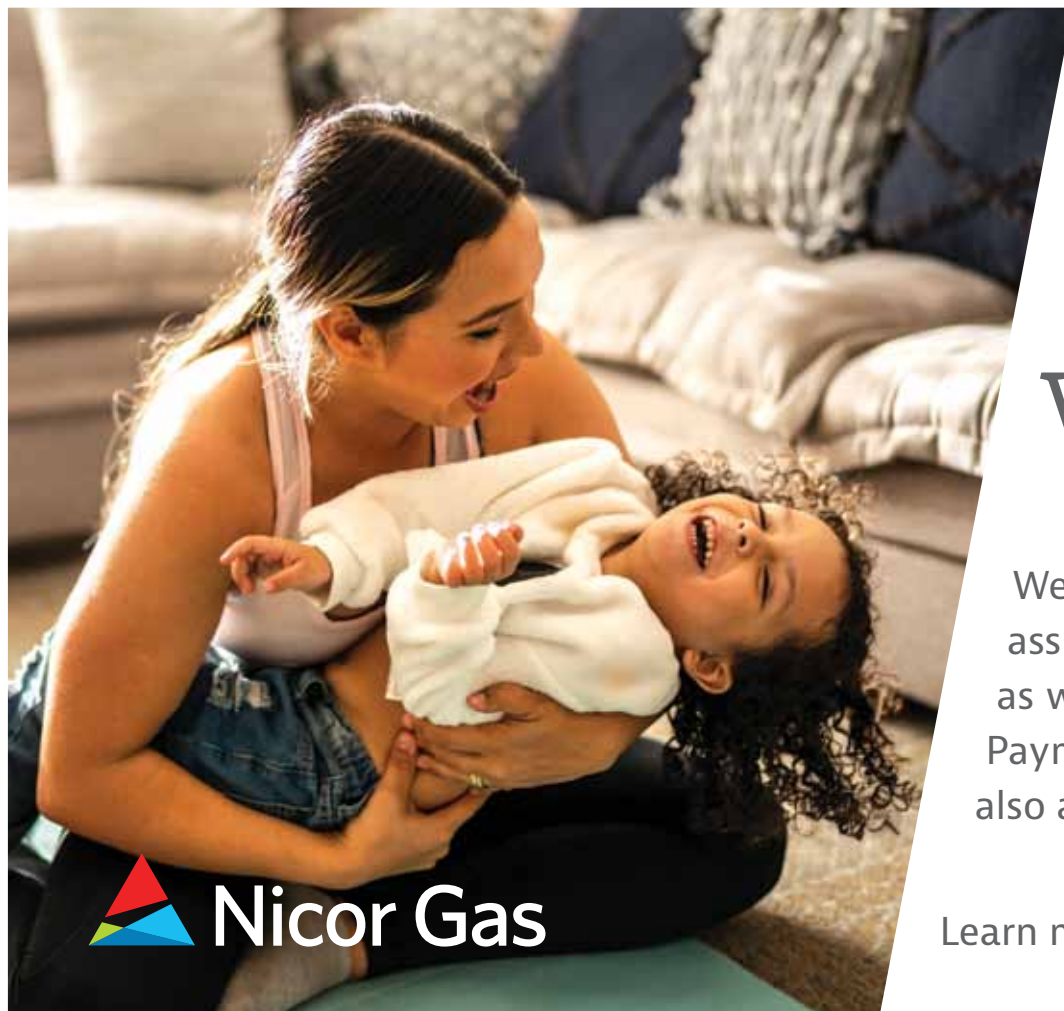


time at CommunityHealth," said State Senator Celina Villanueva. "It's always been a part of my family's DNA to be of service and whenever there are incredible things happening in the district we should be celebrating, especially in the middle of chaos and with everything that is going on in the world. It's wonderful to be able to

celebrate these achievements of people coming together and saying 'we share similar values and beliefs in the access to healthcare for our communities.'" Cook County Clerk Monica Gordon reaffirmed her commitment to expanding equal access to the ballot, announcing the opening of two new locations as the Clerk's Office kicks off Early Voting for the April 1 Consolidated Election in suburban Cook County. The Clerk's Office has opened two new locations at Universal School in Bridgeview, and the Lyons Township Office in Countryside, bringing the total number of Early Voting locations to 55 across suburban Cook County. The openings are part of Clerk Gordon's ongoing effort to make voting more accessible, convenient, and secure for all eligible voters. Suburban voters can cast their ballot at any of the



55 Early Voting locations regardless of where they live throughout the Early Voting period, which kicked off March 17 and runs through March 31. The new Early Voting location at Universal

School will in Bridgeview will serve the area's growing Arab American and Muslim community to help ensure representation in the electoral process. Meanwhile, the Countryside site improves

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Watch Baby Sea Stars Grow in Shedd Aquarium's Care with Debut on Exhibit

Tucked in a small habitat in Shedd Aquarium's Polar Play Zone, a group of tiny orange-brown sea stars tell a much bigger story. Over the past year, Shedd has been raising critically endangered sunflower sea stars (*Pycnopodia helianthoides*) as part of the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) Saving Animals From Extinction (SAFE) program. Now, guests have the chance

to spot the growing sea stars on exhibit and learn about how these animals serve as ambassadors for the threats facing their wild counterparts. The sunflower sea star is one of the largest species of sea stars in the world, growing up to three feet in diameter with up to 24 arms. Yet in their larval form, the sea stars are microscopic in size. Since arriving in early 2024, the animals grew over 16,000 percent and are

currently around two inches in diameter. Sunflower sea stars are a keystone species in kelp forests, meaning they are vitally important to the health of the ecosystem. The sea stars eat urchins, which prevents the urchins from overgrazing and destroying the kelp. In other words, sunflower sea stars help protect the habitats of animals like sea otters, leopard sharks, giant sea bass and many others.

Veá Cómo Crecen las Crías de Estrellas de Mar en el Care del Acuario Shedd con su Debut en Exhibición

Escondido en un pequeño hábitat en la Zona de Juego Polar del Acuario Shedd, un grupo de diminutas estrellas de mar de color marrón anaranjado cuentan una historia mucho más grande. Durante el último año, Shedd ha estado criando estrellas de mar girasol (*Pycnopodia helianthoides*), una especie en crítico peligro de extinción, como parte del Programa Salvando Animales de la Extinción (SAFE) de la Asociación de Zoológicos y Acuarios (AZA). Ahora,

los visitantes tienen la oportunidad de observar las estrellas de mar en crecimiento en exhibición y aprender sobre cómo estos animales sirven como embajadores de las amenazas que enfrentan sus contrapartes salvajes. La estrella de mar girasol es una de las especies más grandes de estrellas de mar en el mundo, cree hasta tres pies en diámetro, con hasta 24 brazos. Sin embargo en su forma de larva, las estrellas de mar son microscópicas en tamaño. Desde que llegaron

a principios del 2024, los animales crecieron más de 16,000 por ciento y tienen actualmente dos pulgadas de diámetro. Las estrellas de mar girasol son una especie clave en los bosques de algas, lo que significa que son vitales para la salud del ecosistema. Se alimentan de erizos, lo que evita que estos sobre pastoreen y destruyan las algas. En otras palabras, las estrellas de mar girasol ayudan a proteger los hábitats de animales como nutrias marinas, tiburones leopardo, lubinas gigantes.

Brookfield Zoo Chicago is blooming with excitement in anticipation of its spring event lineup, announcing its signature events scheduled through May 2025. The annual first sign of spring at Brookfield Zoo Chicago was seen on March 10, when the herd of reticulated giraffes (*Giraffa camelopardalis reticulata*) stretched their legs outside at *Habitat*

Africa! The Savannah. Just as Chicagoans embrace the sunshine, guests can also expect to see more animals exploring their outdoor habitats in the warm weather ahead. This spring schedule of events will be complemented by a full lineup of summer and winter fun—including the return of the popular Ferris Wheel and the Roaring Nights concert

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Cook County Assessor's Office Releases Permits Dataset

The Cook County Assessor's Office released a new public dataset containing building permits submitted to the office by municipalities. The data can be found on Cook County's Open Data Portal. This release creates access to the data for all permits stored in iasWorld, the office's system of record. Publishing the data allows users to search (for example, for a specific municipality), filter, sort, and download the data. More than half a million rows of permit

data are included in the dataset. Permits list new construction and changes to a property that can change its assessed value and grow the tax base. The CCAO receives permits from municipalities and sorts them, determining whether the kind of work done on the property is likely to result in a new assessed value. If it is, a field inspection may take place. Permits are also used to administer the Home Improvement Exemption. When homeowners add an improvement to their home,

they aren't taxed on up to \$75,000 of the added value for up to four years. The CCAO automatically applies this exemption after receiving a building permit and conducting a field check on the property. Over the last six years, the CCAO has hired more staff, implemented new technology, and improved our processes to better capture accurate data from permits. In addition



to the release of this dataset, our office has made several other recent changes to eliminate bottlenecks and improve accuracy in our permit processing.

Vino Chileno ingresa a China libre de impuestos

El vino chileno ahora puede ingresar a China libre de impuestos tras un acuerdo entre Chile y China para permitir la venta de vinos tintos y blancos chilenos en el mercado chino. Esto convierte al vino chileno en el segundo mayor importador de vino del mercado chino, solo después de Francia, que tiene un acuerdo con China para permitir la entrada de vinos franceses libres de impuestos. Chile es el quinto mayor productor y exportador de vino del mundo, solo después de Francia, Italia, España y Estados Unidos. Originalmente, China importaba vinos de Australia, pero debido a varias disputas con Australia, China ha estado importando vinos de otros lugares.



Evo Morales se esconde en la selva Boliviana

El expresidente Boliviano Evo Morales se esconde de las fuerzas del orden Bolivianas en un recinto en la selva, custodiado por miles de seguidores. Morales ha sido acusado por el gobierno Boliviano de trata de personas y estupro. Aunque el actual gobierno Boliviano ha dictaminado



que Morales no puede volver a postularse a la presidencia, Morales ha prometido regresar al poder. Muchos Bolivianos de bajos recursos, especialmente los indígenas, recuerdan la época en que Morales gobernó Bolivia durante catorce años, y muchos Bolivianos consideraron su administración como una "época dorada". Actualmente, muchos Bolivianos están desilusionados con el actual gobierno Boliviano, ya que la inflación se dispara y la escasez de combustible deja a muchos Bolivianos de bajos recursos sin calefacción.

La Oficina del Evaluador del Condado de Cook Publica Conjunto de Datos de Permisos

La Oficina del Evaluador de Impuestos del Condado de Cook publicó un nuevo conjunto de datos públicos que contiene los permisos de construcción enviados a la oficina por los municipios. Los datos se pueden encontrar en el portal de datos abiertos del Condado de Cook. Esta publicación da acceso a los datos de todos los permisos archivados en iasWorld, sistema de récords de la oficina. La publicación de los datos permite a los usuarios buscar (por ejemplo, una municipalidad específica) filtrar, separar y descargar los datos. Más de medio millón de hileras de datos de permisos están incluidos en la base de datos. Los permisos enumeran nuevas construcciones y cambios a una propiedad que pueden cambiar su valor tasado y aumentar

la base impositiva. CCAO recibe permisos de municipalidades y los separa, determinando si la clase de trabajo hecho en la propiedad resulta probablemente en un nuevo valor tasado. Si es así, puede llevarse a cabo una inspección de campo. Los permisos son utilizados también para administrar la Exención de Mejoras en el Hogar. Cuando los propietarios agregan una mejora a su casa, no se gravan hasta 75.000 dólares del valor añadido durante un máximo de cuatro años. CCAO automáticamente aplica esta exención tras recibir un permiso de edificios y conducir una revisión de campo en la propiedad. En los últimos seis años, CCAO ha contratado más personal, implementado nueva tecnología y mejorado nuestros

The Uruguayan Congress is divided on the issue of euthanasia. Those in support of the bill believe it will give those who are dying a dignified ending of life. Those opposed believe that the bill will allow for unscrupulous people to use such a law to make individuals end their lives for a profit. The Uruguayan legislators are looking at ways if it is possible to put in protections for ending a person's life with dignity if this is possible.

Chilean Wine Enters China Tax-free



Chilean wine is now being allowed to enter China tax-free after Chile and China came to an agreement to allow Chilean red and white wines to be sold in Chinese markets. This makes Chilean wine the second major wine import into the China market only after France, which has an agreement with China, for China to allow in French wines tax-free. Chile is the fifth largest producer and exporter of wine in the world only after France, Italy, Spain and the United States. Originally China had imported wines from Australia, but due to a number of disputes with Australia, China has since been importing wines from elsewhere.

Evo Morales Hiding in the Bolivian Jungle

Former Bolivian President Evo Morales is hiding from Bolivian law enforcement in a jungle compound guarded by thousands of followers. Morales has been charged by the Bolivian government with human trafficking and statutory rape. Although the current Bolivian government has ruled that Morales is ineligible to run for president again, Morales has vowed to return to power. Many poorer Bolivians, especially the indigenous peoples, remember when Morales ruled Bolivia for fourteen years, and many Bolivians considered his administration as a "golden age." Presently many Bolivians are disillusioned with the current Bolivian government as inflation runs rampant and fuel shortages leave many poorer Bolivians without heat.



Argentine River Turns Blood Red

The Sarandi River turned blood red without explanation. According to residents living along the river, the Sarandi emitted a strong stench. Initial investigations could not pinpoint

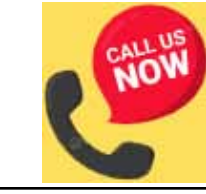
