Chicago Fire Unveils Plans for \$650M Soccer Stadium in Waterfront Neighborhood

The Chicago Fire Football Club surprised the city earlier this week by announcing plans for a new \$650 million stadium near downtown Chicago, occupying a site that has long been sought by developers for its prime location. The stadium, which would be financed by club owner and Chicago native Joe Mansueto, would serve as the anchor for "The 78," a name for the city's unofficial 78th community area near the city's central business district. The soon-to-be developed Chicago neighborhood, in the South Loop, sits on Roosevelt along the Chicago River. The name for the new neighborhood,

"The 78," was given its name to reference Chicago's 77 officially defined "community areas." Plans for the mixed-use, \$7 billion neighborhood include seven acres of green space, a five-acre sports part, entertainment, retail, housing, dining and more, according to the Chicago Fire website. The new, open-air stadium will seat 22,000 fans, the announcement said, with the initial phase of construction scheduled for fall 2025 or early 2026. It's expected to open in 2028, ahead of the MLS regular season.

El Chicago Fire Football Club sorprendió a la ciudad a principios de esta semana al anunciar planes para un nuevo estadio de \$650 millones cerca del centro de Chicago, que ocupará un sitio que los desarrolladores inmobiliarios han buscado durante mucho tiempo por su ubicación privilegiada. El estadio, que sería financiado por el propietario del club y nativo de Chicago, Joe Mansueto, serviría como ancla para "The 78", un nombre para el área comunitaria no oficial del 78 ° distrito de la ciudad, cerca del distrito comercial central de la ciudad. El vecindario de Chicago, que pronto será desarrollado, en el South Loop, se encuentra en Roosevelt a lo largo del río Chicago. El nombre para el nuevo vecindario, "The 78", recibió su nombre para hacer



referencia a las 77 "áreas comunitarias" oficialmente definidas de Chicago. Los planes para el vecindario de uso mixto de \$7 mil millones incluyen siete acres de espacio verde, un área deportiva de cinco

acres, entretenimiento, tiendas minoristas, viviendas, restaurantes y más, según el sitio web de Chicago Fire. El nuevo estadio al aire libre tendrá capacidad para 22.000 aficionados, según el anuncio, y la fase

The event came immediately after the Illinois General Assembly passed legislation to extend the CCAO's Affordable



Housing Special Assessment Program to 2034. AHSAP provides an incentive for housing providers and developers that preserve or create affordable housing across Cook County. A recent

data analysis by the CCAO showed that more than 700 multifamily properties that participated in the first two years of AHSAP preserved over 10,000 units of affordable housing, saving \$13 million in property taxes


