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Entra en Vigor Nuevo Requisito de SNAP

El último requisito federal de trabajo del programa SNAP entrará en vigor el viernes 1° de mayo, poniendo a miles de residentes en riesgo de perder sus beneficios. En una conferencia de prensa el lunes por la mañana en Living Fresh Market en Forest Park, La Ejecutiva Sénior Melody Winston y la Vicepresidenta de Política y Defensa de Greater Chicago Food Depository, Danielle Perry, se pronunciaron en contra de los cambios y explicaron cómo deberían prepararse

los residentes.

En Living Fresh Market en Forest Park, los líderes dijeron que SNAP es una importante parte de su base al cliente. “El pequeño empresario es el que lucha por la comunidad, el pequeño empresario es el que está aquí no importa lo que pase”, dijo Winston. El mercado calcula que una tercera parte de sus clientes confían en los beneficios de SNAP. El nuevo cambio pide ahora que ciertos recipientes de SNAP registren por lo menos 80 horas al mes de trabajo, entrenamiento o voluntariado, para mantener sus beneficios. La política parte de cambios federales incluidos en el proyecto “One Big Beautiful Bill” [Un Gran y Hermoso Billeto] del Presidente Donald Trump el pasado febrero. El nuevo requisito pondrá a la gente en riesgo de perder su ayuda en comida, de acuerdo al Departamento

de Servicios Humanos de Illinois y Greater Chicago Food Depository. “Por cada comida que damos... SNAP da 9”, dijo Perry. El requisito aplica a personas adultas de 18 a 64 años que pueden trabajar y no tienen niños menores de 14 años en casa, en base a la guía del Departamento de Servicios Humanos. Los recursos apoyados por el estado incluyen a Job Ready Illinois por horas de entrenamiento y a Serve.Illinois.gov por oportunidades de voluntariado. Guías adicionales disponibles en


snapworkrequirements.illinois.gov. Tantos como 150,000 participantes de SNAP en Illinois están en peligro de perder sus beneficios para el 1º de mayo, de acuerdo a Greater Chicago Food Depository. “No es demasiado tarde”, dijo Perry. “Ese es el mensaje número que necesitamos pasar a todos ahora mismo”. La gente puede calificar para exenciones, incluyendo si están embarazadas o cuidando niños pequeños. El estado pide a los recipientes que revisen su elegibilidad


y reporten su actividad de trabajo a través del portal de beneficios en abe.illinois.gov. “En resumen, nuestra organización benéfica no puede suplir lo que el programa SNAP puede hacer por cada comida. Nosotros proporcionamos un sistema de alimentación de emergencia en una despensa o en un comedor social”, dijo Perry.

A todos los que actualmente están en SNAP, se les pide asegurarse de que revisen en el Departamento de Servicios Humanos de Illinois para ver si pueden calificar para una exención, si no, asegúrense de que su información de trabajo está al día. 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New SNAP Requirement Takes Effect

The latest federal SNAP work requirement will take effect on Friday, May 1st, putting thousands of residents at risk of losing their benefits. At a press conference Monday morning at the Living Fresh Market in Forest Park, Senior Executive Melody Winston and Vice President of Policy and Advocacy for the Greater Chicago Food Depository Danielle Perry spoke out against the changes and how residents should prepare.

At Living Fresh Market in Forest Park, leaders say SNAP is a significant part of their customer base. “The little guy is the one who is fighting for community, the little guy is the one who stays here no matter what the margins are,” said Winston. The market estimates about

one-third of its customers rely on SNAP benefits. Store leaders say a drop in those benefits will reduce sales and affect vendors operating inside the store. The new requirement will now require certain SNAP recipients to log at least 80 hours a month of work, training or volunteer time to keep benefits. The policy stems from federal changes included in President Donald Trump’s “One Big Beautiful Bill,” last February. The new requirement will put people at risk of losing their food assistance, according to the Illinois Department of Human Services and the Greater Chicago Food Depository. “For every meal we provide ... SNAP provides 9,” said Perry. The requirement applies to adult’s ages 18 to 64 who are able to work and do not have children

under 14 at home, based on guidance from the Illinois Department of Human Services. State-supported resources include Job Ready Illinois for training hours and Serve. Illinois.gov for volunteer opportunities. Additional guidance is available at snapworkrequirements.illinois.gov.

As many as 150,000 Illinois SNAP participants are on track to lose their benefits by May 1st, according to the Greater Chicago Food Depository. “It’s not too late,” said Perry. “That is the number one message we need to tell everyone right now.” People can qualify for exemptions, including if they are pregnant or caring for young children. The state directs recipients to check eligibility and report work activity through its benefit’s portal at abe.illinois.gov.



illinois.gov. “In short our charity can’t make up for what SNAP can do for every meal. We provide an emergency food system at a pantry or a soup kitchen,” said Perry.

Everyone currently on SNAP is being asked to make sure they check in with the Illinois

Department of Human Services to see if they can qualify for an exemption, if not make sure their work information is up to date. For more information or to see if you qualify, visit www.saveoursnap.org. You can also update your information by calling 1-800-843-6154. For a list

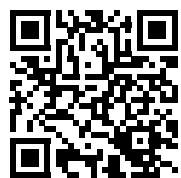

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Battle of Tampico (1829)

[Cinco de Mayo, or May 5, 1862, was a major Mexican victory against the French to secure the sovereignty of the country against enemies and invaders. This was not the only Mexican military victory to save and protect the country. There were others in the 19th Century and 20th Century which saved Mexico in its time of crisis]

Mexico had gained its de facto independence from Spain in 1821. Essentially, it was a unilateral declaration whereby the rebels and the former Spanish loyalists had come together to create an independent country. And while the Spanish did not accept Mexican independence, all the wars of liberation occurring in Cen-

tral and South America prevented the Spanish Empire from trying to do anything about Mexico. This would change with the restoration to power of the conservatives in Spain who envisioned retaking the whole of the Americas starting with Mexico. To this effect, the Spanish Crown under King Ferdinand VII signed the order to invade Mexico. The Spanish had gathered a naval fleet of 3,500 men under the command of General Isidro Barrada who would land this force and march on Mexico City. Through Mexico City, the Spanish intended to crush the Mexican Army and then take over the rest of the country.

The Spanish fleet landed at the city of Tampico on July 26, 1829, which would

become their springboard to march to Mexico City. Prior to the Spanish invasion, Mexican General Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna had evacuated the entire city to make sure that the Spanish would not have any supplies nor draft any Mexicans to help fight against the Mexican Army. Santa Anna had good intelligence on where the Spanish might land, and he wanted to prevent the Spanish from being able to utilize any resources on Mexican soil. Despite this, General Barrada started turning Tampico into a fortress so he could make the city a springboard for his invasion. Santa Anna had an army of 8,000. And while he outnumbered the Spanish, the Spanish had better weapons and the



advantage of a reinforced fortress. In the beginning, Santa Anna tried initial assaults against Tampico to try and weaken the defenses, but each assault by the Mexicans were repulsed with high losses. Seeing that he could not take Tampico by force, Santa Anna decided to besiege the city instead.

The siege tactic bore fruit. While the Mexican forces could not take Tampico, the Spanish could not break out. Worse, General

Barrada could not receive reinforcements from Spain because of stormy seas, and his food and ammunition supplies were dwindling. In addition, disease began to take its toll on his troops. Barrada knew that he was trapped in Tampico with no way of going forward and with stormy seas preventing the Spanish Navy from helping him. Barrada sent an unarmed envoy to the Mexicans requesting a formal surrender. He proposed a surrender whereby

his forces could be evacuated to Cuba and off of Mexican territory. Santa Anna accepted this, and on September 9, 1829, the Spanish surrendered, and in agreement with the Mexicans left all of their weapons behind as the Spanish troops were all evacuated to Cuba. The defeat of the Spanish made Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna a national hero in Mexico, and the Spanish Empire would never again try to invade or reconquer Mexico.

Battle of Queretaro (1867)

Before I say something about this battle, I should explain what happened just before it. The Mexican Army had defeated a French invasion on May 5, 1862 (Cinco de Mayo). That victory, celebrated today in Mexico and among Mexican Americans, only lasted a year. The French came back and with overwhelming force took the Mexican-held forts at Puebla and marched on Mexico City. Seeing no way to defeat this French invasion, then Mexican President Benito Juarez took the Mexican Army northwards and disbursed his forces to prevent the French from destroying the only organized

resistance against them. The Mexican Army became mobile guerrilla units fighting and harassing the French any way they could.

To try and make their rule of Mexico "legitimate," the French selected an Austrian Hapsburg archduke named Maximilian whom they proclaimed Maximilian I, Emperor of the Mexican Empire. The Mexican Empire was an empire in name only; the French actually controlled everything and made-up the majority of the armed forces in Mexico. As long as the French were stationed in Mexico, they remained in firm control of the country. There were two reasons why the French were able to and wanted to remain in control of Mexico. First, the United

States was too engaged in its Civil War (1861-1865) to do anything about the French occupation of Mexico. They certainly did not like the French helping clandestinely the rebel Confederate States of America. Second, the French Emperor Napoleon III wanted to keep Mexico as a colony because of the country's rich resources especially its silver and gold. This brought badly needed gold and silver reserves to the French economy.

This situation would change radically in 1866 when the United States crushed the Confederacy in the Civil War and sided with Benito Juarez. French Emperor Napoleon III saw that the United States was about to intervene in the fight for

Mexico on the side of Juarez, and not wanting a conflict with the United States, he withdrew all French forces from Mexico. Besides, Napoleon III was now concerned about a conflict with Prussia on the European continent, and he needed whatever French forces he could get to fight Prussia. Mexican Emperor Maximilian I was now all alone against the reconstituted forces of the Mexican Army under Benito Juarez with the aid and official recognition of the United States. Without French military help, Maximilian I only had about at most 10,000 Mexican imperial soldiers to fight against a Mexican Army of 42,000.

Against this force, Maximilian I had little to no chance of victory, Maximilian I took what forces he had and went to the town of Queretaro. Queretaro was a well-



fortified strong-hold from where Maximilian I thought he could either hold out until the Mexican Army was too exhausted or even defeat Benito Juarez. This did not happen. The Mexican Army easily overcame the town's defenses and took Queretaro on May 14, 1867. Maximilian and most of his generals were captured, and Benito Juarez eventually had Maxi-

milian I executed on June 19, 1867. The Republic of Mexico was re-proclaimed, and Benito Juarez remained its president until he died in office on July 18, 1872. After the Battle of Queretaro, there would never be another invasion of Mexico by a European power, and Mexico would remain a free and sovereign country into the 20th Century.

The 201st Fighter Squadron's Fight to Liberate Luzon (1945)

Mexico declared on Germany, Italy and Japan on May 22, 1942, after a German U-boat sank two Mexican oil tankers. This brought Mexico on to the side of the United States and the Allied forces. During World War II, Mexican workers helped fill the places in industry and especially agriculture of American men sent off to fight in the war in Europe and the Pacific, and Mexican industries also churned out war material that aided the United States. The Mexican Expeditionary Air Force

was organized to help both the United States and other Allied nations in the fight against the Axis powers. Many of the Mexican pilots were trained in Texas, and Mexican air units helped with Allied supplies in the Pacific theater.

Out of the Mexican Expeditionary Air Force, a special unit was formed known as the 201st Fighter Squadron. Called the "Aztec Eagles," this unit of the Mexican Expeditionary Air Force was given the task of helping the Americans of liberating the island of Luzon in the Philippines in 1945. The Aztec Eagles

bombed and strafed enemy Japanese positions, and because of Japanese anti-aircraft fire the Aztec Eagles took heavy losses. Some of the pilots who managed to bail out of their aircraft were able to parachute into territory held by Philippine guerrilla units. Hence, it was not unusual for Mexican pilots to be helping the Philippine guerrillas fight the Japanese in open battles. Because of their bravery, and their effort

to helping the Americans and the Philippine people, the Aztec Eagles were wel-

comed back to both the United States and Mexico as heroes. Even today, there

is still an Aztec Eagle unit of the Mexican Air Force.

La lucha del 201er Escuadrón de Caza por la liberación de Luzón (1945)

raron con el suministro de provisiones a los Aliados en el teatro de operaciones del Pacífico.

Del 201.er Escuadrón de Caza se formó una unidad especial. Conocida como las "Águilas Aztecas", esta unidad de la Fuerza Aérea Expedicionaria Mexicana recibió la misión de ayudar a los estadounidenses a liberar la isla de Luzón en Filipinas en 1945. Las Águilas Aztecas bombardearon y ametrallaron posiciones japonesas enemigas, y debido al fuego antiaéreo japonés, sufrieron grandes pérdidas. Algunos de los pilotos que lograron eyectarse de sus aviones pudieron lanzarse en paracaídas a territorio controlado por la guerrilla filipina. Por lo tanto, no era inusual que los pilotos mexicanos ayudaran a la guerrilla filipina a combatir a los japoneses en batallas a campo abierto. Gracias a su valentía y su esfuerzo por ayudar a los estadounidenses y al pueblo filipino, las Águilas Aztecas fueron recibidas como héroes tanto en Estados Unidos como en México. Incluso hoy en día, todavía existe una unidad de las Águilas Aztecas en la Fuerza Aérea Mexicana.

México declaró la guerra a Alemania, Italia y Japón el 22 de mayo de 1942, tras el hundimiento de dos petroleros mexicanos por un submarino alemán. Esto lo unió a Estados Unidos y a las fuerzas aliadas. Durante la Segunda Guerra

Mundial, los trabajadores mexicanos contribuyeron a cubrir los puestos en la industria, especialmente en la agricultura, que habían dejado vacantes los estadounidenses enviados a luchar en Europa y el Pacífico. Además, las industrias mexicanas produjeron material bélico que

benefició a Estados Unidos. La Fuerza Aérea Expedicionaria Mexicana se organizó para apoyar tanto a Estados Unidos como a otras naciones aliadas en la lucha contra las potencias del Eje. Muchos pilotos mexicanos se entrenaron en Texas, y las unidades aéreas mexicanas colabo-

Murder Charge Secured Against Chicago Juvenile

A Chicago teenager is facing a charge of first-degree murder because of a shooting investigation by the Cicero Police Department. The incident happened around 8:30 a.m. on April 14 in the 5000 block of 32nd Place in Cicero. There, police found Ruben Alcazar Jr., 32, of Chicago, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds and he was transported to Mt. Sinai Hospital,



where he died. Following a thorough investigation, Cicero detectives identified

a 16-year-old from Chicago as the suspect. He was arrested without incident

on Wednesday, as he exited a hotel in the 6800 block of South Cicero Avenue in Bedford Park. The investigation remains ongoing. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved prosecuting the teenager as an adult and he appeared in court on Friday, where he was ordered to remain in custody. Investigators determined the shooting was the result of an isolated dispute and there is no ongoing threat to the public.

Se Formula Cargo de Asesinato Contra un Menor de Chicago

Un adolescente de Chicago enfrenta un cargo de asesinato en primer grado por una investigación de balacera del Departamento de Policía de Cicero. El incidente ocurrió alrededor de las 8:30 a.m. el 14 de abril en la cuadra 5000 de 32^o Place en Cicero. Ahí, la policía encontró a Rubén Alcazar Jr., de 32 años, de Chicago, sufriendo de

múltiples heridas de bala, siendo transportado al Hospital Mt. Sinai, donde murió. Tras una completa investigación, detectives de Cicero identificaron a un adolescente de 16 años de Chicago, como el sospechoso. Este fue arrestado sin incidente el miércoles, cuando salía de un hotel en la cuadra 6800 de S. Cicero Ave., en Bedford



Park. La investigación continúa. La Oficina del Procurador del Estado del Condado de Cook aprobó el procesamiento del adolescente como adulto, mismo que apareció en corte el

viernes, donde se le ordenó permanecer en custodia. Los investigadores determinaron que la balacera fue el resultado de una disputa aislada y no significa amenaza para el público.
