El 29 de enero de 2026, la administración Trump emitió medidas punitivas relacionadas con el petróleo y los aranceles para imponer gravámenes 'ad valorem' a los productos importados de cualquier país que venda o suministre petróleo a Cuba, ya sea directa o indirectamente. El 1º de mayo de 2026 se establecieron sanciones secundarias que permiten a Estados Unidos bloquear activos y restringir el acceso al sistema estadounidense a personas e instituciones financieras extranjeras que operen en sectores designados de la economía cubana (incluidos los de energía, defensa y minería) o que brinden apoyo financiero al gobierno de Cuba.

# Improving Cuban Relations

Earlier this month, the non-profit Latino Art Beat had the distinct honor to host Cuban Deputy Chief of Mission of the Embassy of Cuba the Honorable Ambassador Tanieris Dieguez as part of a Chicago historic tour to improve relations between the United States and Cuba. Ambassador Dieguez visited the Institute for the Study of Ancient Cultures Museum, ISAC (formerly the Oriental Institute) of the University of Chicago as well as the Roseland Community Hospital. Amid her visit, Ambassador Dieguez spoke with Lawndale Bilingual News about the importance of developing a healthy dialogue between the United States and Cuba and just how the oil blockade has affected the lives of the Cuban people. On January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026 the Trump administration issues an oil and tariff penalties to impose punishing ad valorem tariffs on goods imported from any country that directly or indirectly sells or provides oil to Cuba. On May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026 a Secondary Sanctions was issued that allows the U.S. to block assets and restrict U.S. access for foreign individuals and financial institutions that operate in “designated sectors of the Cuban economy (including energy, defense,

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## Property Values for Cicero Township Released

Cook County Assessor Fritz Kaegi released the initial assessments of residential and commercial properties in Cicero Township on June 17, 2026. The Assessor's Office reassesses one-third of Cook County every year. The south and west suburbs were last reassessed in 2023. Cicero Township is coterminous with the town of Cicero. "I strongly encourage property owners to review their reassessment notice to ensure their property characteristics and market value reflect their home," said Assessor Fritz Kaegi. "It is important to understand that assessments in Cook County reflect market value over the last three years. My office will be hosting a virtual workshop to assist property owners and explain reassessments in their community." Appeals for Cicero Township must be submitted by July 31, 2026. Property owners

are given an opportunity to appeal their assessment if the property characteristics listed on an assessment notice are incorrect, or if the estimated market value of a property is significantly more than what it could sell for in the current real estate market. 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
