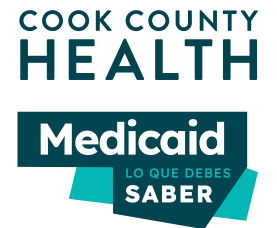

Cicero Ayuda a los Residentes a Obtener la Ciudadanía

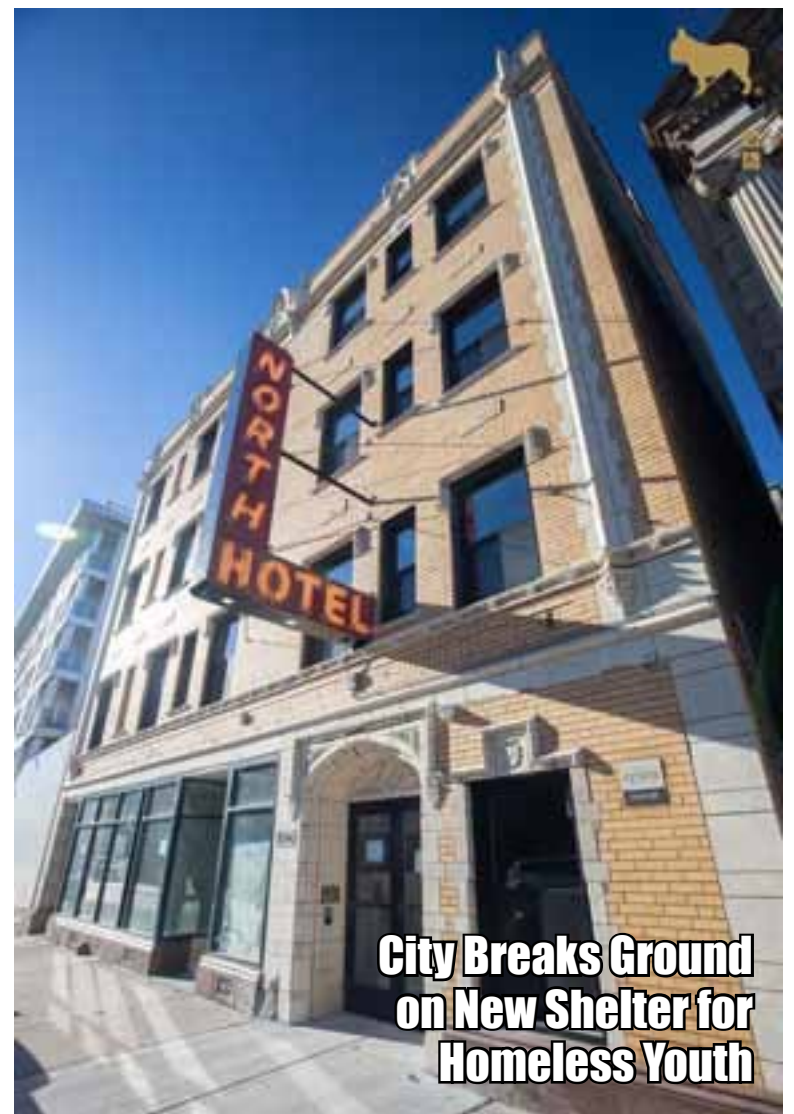

Funcionarios de la Ciudad de Chicago se unieron al equipo de La Casa Norte para poner la primera piedra de North Hotel en La Casa Norte, un albergue no colectivo respaldado por la ciudad, diseñado para atender a jóvenes adultos sin hogar, el miércoles por la mañana. El Alcalde Brandon Johnson, el Concejal Jessie Fuentes, la Comisionada del Departamento de la Vivienda, Lissette Castañeda, la Comisionada del Departamento de Servicios Familiares y de Apoyo, Angela Green, el equipo en La Casa Norte y miembros de la comunidad de Humboldt Park, que asistieron a la ceremonia de la primera piedra. El North Hotel de la Casa Norte ayudará a apoyar el sistema de albergue de Chicago, mientras se asegura que los jóvenes en desventaja tienen acceso a recursos de apoyo indispensables. Apoyando la rehabilitación de este espacio, nuestra administración está invirtiendo en estabilidad y oportunidad para algunos de los miembros más vulnerables de nuestras comunidades", dijo el Alcalde Brandon Johnson.

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City Breaks Ground on New Shelter for Homeless Youth

City of Chicago officials joined the La Casa Norte team to break ground on La Casa Norte's North Hotel, a City-supported non-congregate shelter designed to serve young adults experiencing homelessness Wednesday morning. Mayor Brandon Johnson, Alderperson Jessie Fuentes, Department of Housing Commissioner Lissette Castañeda, Department of Family and Support Services Commissioner Angela Green, the team at La Casa Norte, and members of the Humboldt Park community were all in

attendance for the groundbreaking ceremony. "La Casa Norte's North Hotel will help support Chicago's shelter system while ensuring disadvantaged youth have access to critical support resources. By supporting the rehabilitation of this space, our administration is investing in stability and opportunity for some of the most vulnerable members of our communities", said Mayor Brandon Johnson.

La Casa Norte acquired the former North Hotel at 1622 N. California Avenue and will work to rehabilitate the space into an expansive shelter serving unhoused youth ages 18-24.

The facility will include 40 rooms, with each unit comprising a private bedroom, en-suite bathroom, and mini kitchenette to promote privacy, dignity, and safety. "La Casa Norte's North Hotel will be the life-giving sanctuary that my most vulnerable former students could have benefited from. I am grateful to have La Casa Norte's North Hotel situated between so many amenities that make this community strong and vibrant," said Ald. Fuentes. "Youth come to La Casa Norte in crisis, unsure of what the future holds," said Jose M. Muñoz, CEO of La Casa Norte. "The North

Summer 2026 Youth Employment Program, which has provided more than 2,300 young residents with paid summer jobs, exposing participants to career pathways, educational opportunities, and experiences that help prevent summer learning loss.

Hotel youth non-congregate shelter gives them a space of their own to heal, and a team dedicated to helping them dream again. This is the future of how we end youth homelessness." The North Hotel will operate 24/7 and provide a comprehensive array of services supporting youth in their transition toward

long-term housing stability, self-sufficiency, and independence. The project will convert vacant ground-floor retail space into a community and service area where residents can access workforce development, career planning, physical and mental health care, family reunification assistance, and other resources. The

project is being supported by \$4.09 million through the Chicago Neighborhood Recovery Program. Residents have already begun to move into the building, while rehabilitation of the main floor is underway and expected to be completed as soon as the end of the 2027 year.

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Medicaid Changes Underway:

Some patients will soon have to meet new criteria to be eligible for Medicaid under the One Big Beautiful Bill Act and medical experts are urging patients to go over their plan to avoid losing coverage. “The time to look over your plan is now and for those who have yet to apply for Medicaid should do so now,” said Chief Medical Officer for CountyCare Dr. Audrey Tanksley. “We know these changes can be overwhelming and confusing, but much like we did when the SNAP benefits rolled out, we are traveling to various communities across the county and arming residents

with as much information as possible.” Among the changes, immigration status. Beginning October 1st, federal policy changes will restrict certain immigrant groups from fully accessing Medicaid benefits. Some noncitizens will no longer qualify for federally funded Medicaid, however qualifying groups to Medicaid include:

Naturalized Citizens
Born in the U.S., or became a citizen
Lawful Permanent Resident (Green Card holder)

If subject to the 5-year bar (wait period), must have met the 5-year bar OR are



According to the Latino Policy and Politics Institute, Latinos represent a large share of Medicaid recipients in the state of Illinois, particularly among low-income households and nearly 65 percent of Latino children are covered. Latino communities in Illinois rely heavily on Medicaid, with nearly one-third of Latino residents enrolled, according to the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services. Dr. Tanksley urges residents to attend a CountyCare Redetermination event to have their questions answered. 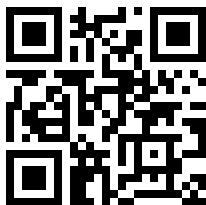
