La introducción de armas de electrochoque de baja visibilidad en nuestro sistema de control migratorio constituye una escalada inaceptable que prioriza la intimidación física y el uso de la fuerza sin rendición de cuentas por encima de la seguridad humana y la responsabilidad administrativa. La agencia sostiene que estos dispositivos reducen su dependencia de la fuerza física y, en situaciones de mayor peligro ofrecen a los agentes una alternativa al uso de armas de fuego. “Actualmente, ICE no dispone de un dispositivo de uso de la fuerza para situaciones de contacto físico directo que pueda suministrar al personal de campo —en medio de

niveles sin precedentes de amenazas y violencia contra sus oficiales y agentes— para ayudar a garantizar que puedan rebajar la tensión en situaciones críticas antes de que se tornen violentas”, señaló la agencia en documentos de adquisición.

El manual de uso de G.L.O.V.E dice que

pueden aumentar el riesgo de muerte repentina y no debe ser un arma contra los ancianos, niños pequeños, mujeres embarazadas y quienes estén gravemente discapacitados”, Aunque DHS no ha compartido detalles sobre el entrenamiento que recibirán los agentes, el vocero de la agencia dice que todos los

oficiales están “altamente entrenados en técnicas de desescalada. Complan Technologies, con base en Kentucky, obtuvo un contrato no competitivo de \$16.7 millones para producir los guantes para ICE. Es la primera vez que la compañía ha recibido un contrato del gobierno de E.U.

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Lawmakers Call Out DHS Over ICE Plans to Use Electric Shock Gloves

U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement has granted a \$16.7 million contract for more than 6,000 gloves that can deliver electric shocks, a new tool that the agency states will help officers control resisting detainees and avoid using “more serious or lethal weapons.” Officially called the Generated Low Output Voltage Emitters (G.L.O.V.E.), ICE describes the gloves as “conductive distraction and de-escalation devices,” says the new equipment will offer personnel a lower-impact option during arrests, detainee transports and disturbances surrounding detention facilities. According to the agency’s procurement rationale, the gloves may be used when a person is “actively or passively resisting” and an officer

needs to gain control quickly.

As a response, Democratic lawmakers, such as Congresswoman Delia C. Ramirez (IL-03), and Congressman Jesus “Chuy” Garcia are demanding an immediate cancellation of the new tool. In a letter signed by over 50 lawmakers to the U.S. Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS, Ramirez and Garcia are deeming the G.L.O.V.E., as “unacceptable,” and are urging ICE agents to put a stop to what is a “human rights violation.”

“Introducing low-visibility electric shock weapons into our immigration enforcement system is an unacceptable escalation that prioritizes physical intimidation and unaccountable force over human safety and administrative accountability. We reiterate our demand that

you immediately halt the acquisition and deployment of electric shock gloves, cancel the contract, and refocus the Department’s resources on accountability and humanitarian standards rather than expanding a paramilitary apparatus,” wrote the lawmakers.

The agency argues the devices reduce agency reliance on physical force and, in more dangerous encounters, grant officers an alternative to resorting to a firearm. “ICE does not currently have an empty hand use of force device to provide to the field amidst unprecedented levels of threats and violence against ICE officers and agents to help ensure they can de-escalate tense situations before they turn violent,” the agency wrote in procurement documents. The G.L.O.V.E. user manual says they may increase the risk of sudden death and should not be a



tool against the elderly, small children, pregnant women and those who are “severely handicapped.” While DHS has not shared details about the training

agents would receive, the agency spokesperson said all officers are “highly trained in de-escalation techniques.” Compliant Technologies, based in

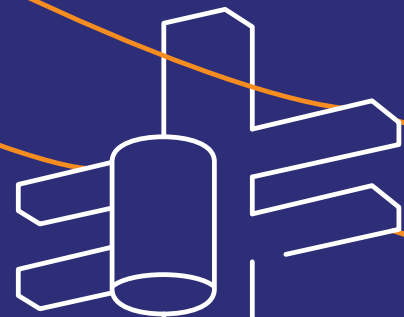
Kentucky, won a \$16.7 million non-competitive contract to produce the gloves for ICE. It marks the first time the company has received a U.S. government contract.

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Attorney General Raoul Secures Order Temporarily Blocking the U.S. Postal Service’s Mail Voting Rule

Attorney General Kwame Raoul, as part of a coalition of 25 states, has secured a temporary restraining order (TRO) from the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts, temporarily blocking a new rule by the U.S. Postal Service that would have imposed burdensome requirements on vote-by-mail systems ahead of the November 3rd midterm elections. The order blocks the Postal Service from requiring states to obtain the federal government’s approval of ballot and return-envelope designs, register for a new Postal Service portal for tracking voter information, input information for each of their state’s voters into the portal and comply with other provisions. In granting the TRO, the court found that compliance with the rule before the November



elections is “practically impossible,” noting that states do not have the time to redesign and produce new ballots, update state-administered election systems, train state and local election officials and upload a massive set of voter information to a new federal portal. The court concluded that states face irreparable harm because many had already ordered their ballots, with some states required by state law to begin sending them to voters as early as next week.



El Fiscal General Raoul Obtiene Orden que Bloquea Temporalmente la Norma del Servicio Postal de los E.U. Sobre el Voto por Correo

El Fiscal General Kwame Raoul, como parte de una coalición de 25 estados, ha obtenido una orden de restricción temporal (TRO) de la Corte del Distrito de E.U., para el Distrito de Massachusetts, temporalmente bloqueando una nueva regla del Servicio Postal de E.U. que habría impuesto requisitos onerosos a los sistemas de voto por correo de cara a las elecciones de mitad de mandato del 3 de noviembre. La orden impide que el Servicio Postal exija a los estados obtener la aprobación del

gobierno federal para los diseños de las boletas y los sobres de devolución, registrarse en un nuevo portal del Servicio Postal para el seguimiento de la información de los votantes, ingresar los datos de los votantes de cada estado en dicho sistema y cumplir con otras disposiciones. Al conceder la orden de restricción temporal, el tribunal determinó que cumplir con la norma antes de las elecciones de noviembre es “prácticamente imposible”, señalando que los estados no disponen de tiempo

suficiente para rediseñar y producir nuevas papeletas, actualizar los sistemas electorales estatales, capacitar a los funcionarios electorales —tanto estatales como locales— y cargar un volumen masivo de información de votantes en un nuevo portal federal. El tribunal concluyó que los estados se enfrentan a un perjuicio irreparable, dado que muchos ya habían encargado sus papeletas y algunos están obligados por la legislación estatal a comenzar a enviarlas a los votantes tan pronto como la próxima semana.



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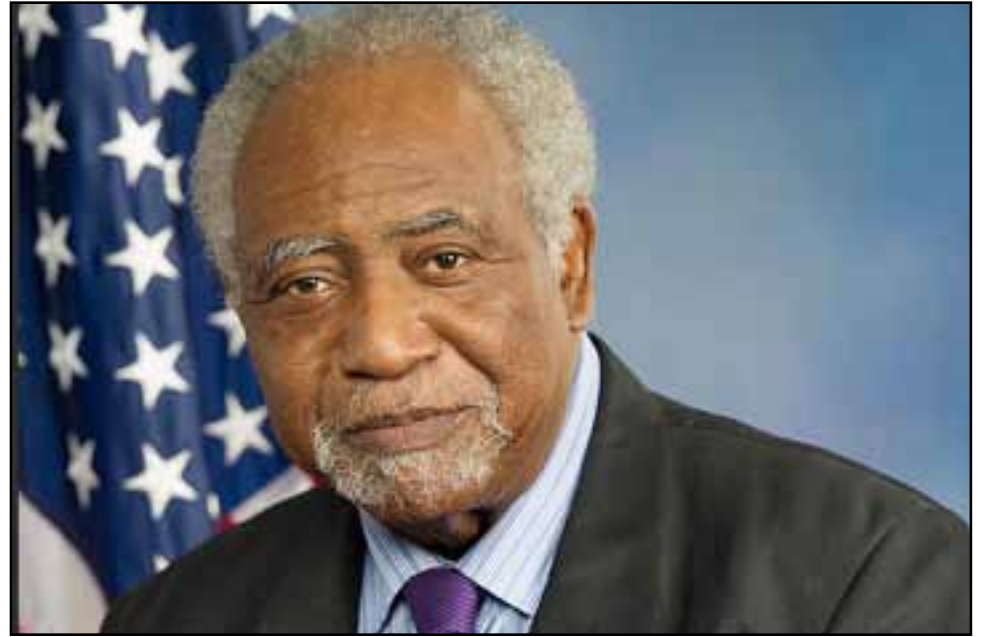

These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the Town of Cicero.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about September 24, 2026, the Town of Cicero will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake a project known as the 59th Avenue Sewer Repair Project for the purpose of replacing the existing combined sewer with a new sewer designed to accommodate a 10-year storm event.

The total project cost is \$3,013,742, the entirety of which would be HUD CDBG-DR funds.

The proposed 59th Avenue Sewer Repair Project would be sited within the existing South 59th Avenue right-of-way and would extend from Roosevelt Road to 16th Street (see Appendix A). The existing sewer is located approximately 3.5 to 5 feet below ground surface. The new sewer would be installed at depths ranging from 6 to 9.5 feet below ground surface, with an average depth of approximately 8 feet. Some lateral sewers would be installed at a depth of approximately 3.5 feet. The project would include approximately 3,180 linear feet of pipe, consisting of 960 feet of 12-inch pipe, 980 feet of 15-inch pipe, 620 feet of 18-inch pipe, and 620 feet of 24-inch pipe. Ground disturbance within the existing right-of-way would be approximately 8 feet wide. Manholes and inlets would also be replaced along the sewer line.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Town of Cicero has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the Town of Cicero Department of Housing; 1634 South Laramie Avenue, Cicero, Illinois 60804 and may be examined or copied Monday-Thursday 8 A.M to 8 P.M. The ERR is also available on the Town’s website at <https://thetownofcicero.com/departments/cdbgdr/important-notice/> or on HUD’s website at <https://cpd.hud.gov/cpd-public/environmental-reviews>.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Argelia Marquez, Assistant Grant Administrator for the Town of Cicero Department of Housing, amarquez@thetownofcicero.com. All comments received by September 23, 2026 will be considered by the Town of Cicero prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Town of Cicero certifies to HUD that Tom M. Tomschin in his capacity as Executive Director, Department of Housing, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD’s approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Town of Cicero to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of fund and the Town of Cicero’s certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Town of Cicero; (b) the Town of Cicero has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD Region 5 at 77 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois 60604. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.

Federal Judge Sentences Man to 19 Years in Prison for Violently Robbing Two Banks in Downtown Chicago

A federal judge has sentenced a man to 19 years in prison for violently robbing two banks in downtown Chicago. Jawad H. Hakeem, 51, of Waukegan, Ill., committed two armed bank robberies within a week in 2023. The first robbery occurred on March 3, 2023, at a Chase Bank branch in Chicago’s River North neighborhood. The second robbery occurred on March 9, 2023, at a Fifth Third Bank branch in Chicago’s Loop neighborhood. In both robberies, Hakeem brandished a handgun at bank tellers and customers. In the second robbery, Hakeem fired nine shots



at a security guard, who returned fire, but no one was wounded. Hakeem was arrested on March 13, 2023, in Waukegan, Ill. He has remained in law enforcement custody since then. Hakeem pleaded guilty earlier this year to federal bank robbery and firearm charges. On Aug. 26, 2026, U.S. District Judge John F. Kness sentenced Hakeem to 19

years in federal prison. The sentence was announced by Andrew S. Boutros, United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois, and Ryan Whalen, Acting Special Agent-in-Charge of the Chicago Field Office of the FBI. Valuable assistance was provided by the Chicago Police Department and the Waukegan Police Department.
